## Syllabus for written examination for the post of Scientist 'B' (01-SC&ST)

- General questions (about 5-7 questions) not specifically from any stream.
- M.Sc. Level questions from Natural sciences (about 3-6 questions from each stream), such as mathematics / physics / chemistry / biology.
- B.E. / B.Tech Level questions from engineering subjects (about 3-6 questions from each stream), such as Electronics / Electrical / Chemical / Civil / Mechanical / Environmental engineering.
- Thorough knowledge at science graduate level, i.e. B.Sc. is assumed while framing the questions.

### Notes:

- ✓ It is a mixed up question paper with no sections / divisions. All questions can be attempted by a candidate. However, there will be negative marking for wrong answers as indicated in the question paper.
- ✓ In all there are 60 multiple choice questions in the question paper, not in any particular order.
- ✓ Questions have been drawn from various streams of science and engineering subjects, such as mathematics, physics, chemistry, electronics, mechanical, environmental, civil, electrical, chemical, etc.
- ✓ Actual number of questions from a stream may differ from the given numbers, i.e. 3-5 questions or questions from a stream may be omitted completely.
- ✓ Questions of varying difficulty have been included, e.g. from 'easy to solve' to 'tough to solve', for generality so that there is no preference to any candidate.
