Direction issued under section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act 1986- reg.

WHEREAS, the Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Tirubala Exports, a tannery unit located at Plot No. A-3/3 & A-3/ 2, Jainpur Industrial Area, Kanpur Dehat, Uttar Pradesh (here in after referred as the Unit), was inspected on 31.05.2017, by the team of officials deputed by CPCB and following observations were made:

- 1) During inspection the industry was found operational with generation of 58m³ of wastewater.
- 2) The Unit was processing 400 hides / day as raw material to produce finished leather.
- 3) The Unit has consents for Water Act, 1974 and Air Act, 1981, valid up to 31.12.2019.
- 4) For renewal of authorization of handling of Hazardous and other Waste, the unit has applied to UPPCB.
- 5) The Unit has not obtained NOC for ground water abstraction from CGWA.
- 6) During inspection the CRP was not in operation.
- 7) The Unit has consent for processing wet blue to finished leather, but without prior permission from UPPCB the unit was found processing raw hides to finished leather.
- 8) The Unit has installed OCEMS for measuring the consent parameters in compliance with CPCB / SPCB direction.

AND WHEREAS, CBCB issued show cause notice dated 21.08.2017, under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; to the Unit, and

WHEREAS, the unit replies vide their letters dated: 18.09.2017 and 28.09.2017 were examined and the following observations are made:

- (i) The Unit has submitted the copy of application for Hazardous waste authorization applied to UPPCB.
- (ii) The Unit has applied for NOC from CGWA.
- (iii) The Unit has submitted the raw material (wet blue/split leather) purchase bills and dispatch of finished leather quantity for the period from 01.01.2017 to 31.08.2017 certified by the Chartered Accountant, which indicates that the unit as per consent has used the wet blue/split leather as raw material and not the raw hides during the above said period.
- (iv) In case of wet-blue/split leather as raw material, CRP is not required; however, unit has installed CRP as a measure of safety.

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act 1986, the show cause notice dated 21.08.2017 is hereby revoked and M/s Tirubala Exports, Plot No. A-3/3 & A-3/ 2, Jainpur Industrial Area, Kanpur Dehat, Uttar Pradesh, is directed to comply with the following:

- (i) The Unit shall submit the copy of valid Hazardous waste authorization to CPCB within 15 days of receipt from the UPPCB.
- (ii) The Unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report from laboratory recognised under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 within 30 days.
- (iii) The Unit shall ensure that treated effluent discharged by the Unit will always comply the ETP standards as per Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, applicable to standalone tannery / as per the consent issued by the UPPCB.
- (iv) The Unit shall always ensure data transmission to CPCB server.

In case of failure of compliance with the above directions CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
