Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 -reg.

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed thereunder; and

WHEREAS, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install and operate Effluent Treatment plant (ETP) to comply with the effluent discharge standards as notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the Rules framed thereunder and also to meet the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Board (SPCB)/ Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and

WHEREAS, Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the matter of Paryavaran Suraksha Samiti Vs Union of India & Others dated 22/02/2017 directed that no industry which requires "consent to operate" from the concerned Pollution Control Board, is permitted to function, unless it has a functional effluent treatment plant, which is capable to meet the prescribed norms for removing the pollutants from the effluent, before it is discharged; and

WHEREAS, a team of officers from the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), Delhi inspected M/s. KSB Textile Pvt. Ltd., Panipat (herein after referred as the Unit) on April 02, 2018 to assess the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures; and

WHEREAS, the inspecting team found the Unit was operational on the day of inspection and observed the following:

1. M/s KSB Textile Pvt. Ltd., a Textile (polyester weaving) Unit, is located at Plot No. 13, Sec. 29, Part 2, Huda Panipat, Haryana.
2. The Unit has not provided any display board at the entrance gate.
3. The Unit is operating illegally without any consent to operate from the Haryana SPCB. The Unit has never applied for consent to operate.
4. The Unit does not have any Effluent Treatment Plant (ETP) and untreated effluent is being discharge into open Drain and land adjoining to the Unit causing severe damage to the environment.
5. The Unit is consuming ground water without permission of Central Ground Water Authority (CGWA).
6. The Unit neither have authorization under hazardous waste rules nor have any agreement with TSDF for disposal of hazardous waste.
7. The Unit representative has informed that premises has been taken on lease from M/s Kesari Handloom Industries (P) Ltd. and consent issued to M/s Kesari Handloom Industries has been expired since March 31, 2015.

WHEREAS it had been observed that the untreated process effluent is being discharged into open drain and land adjoining to the unit, which has all likelihood to damage and cause grave injury to the environment; and

10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the following directions are being issued:

1. The Unit shall close all the plant operations with immediate effect.
2. The Unit shall stop discharge of untreated effluent outside the premises.
3. The Unit shall provide adequate Effluent Treatment Plant so as to achieve prescribed standards for effluent discharge.
4. The Unit shall obtain consent to operate and authorization under Hazardous Waste Rules from the Haryana Pollution Control Board.
5. The Unit shall provide the proper space for the storage of Hazardous waste as per Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.
6. The Unit shall obtain permission from Central Ground Water Authority (CGWA) for withdrawal of ground water for industrial purpose.
7. The Unit shall provide display board at the entrance gate.
8. The Unit shall not resume the operation till the compliance of above direction and permission is obtained from the CPCB for the same.

In case of failure to comply with the said directions necessary action as deemed fit under the provision of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 will be taken by Central Pollution Control Board.


