Terms and conditions:-

1. Sealed quotations should be dropped in the quotation box kept at reception (Ground Floor) of Parivesh Bhawan, CPCB on or before 25.10.2017 by 3.00 pm.
2. The quotation has to be accompanied by an EMD of Rs.1600/- (Rs. One Thousand Six Hundred Only) as Demand Draft in favour of Central Pollution Control Board, Delhi. The EMD of unsuccessful bidders shall be returned after award of work to successful bidder. The EMD of successful bidder shall be deposited in CPCB account and will be refunded after satisfactory completion of work. No interest shall be paid on it.
3. The contract is initially for a period of two (02) year and extendable subject to the satisfactory services provided by the firm.
4. The quotations shall be valid for 03 months from the date of their opening.
5. The bidders have to submit copy of valid registration certificate of CPWD/MES or any other Govt. Organisation, PAN Card, GST no., alongwith the bid.



6. You have to visit and inspect the earth pits, quarterly and if the earthing resistance is found higher than the prescribed limit then the pit has to be recharged. You have to maintain a register for recording the earthing resistance of earth pit.
7. Since, this contract is comprehensive in nature, it includes all the components/materials required to recharge and maintain the earth pit. No other extra charges will be payable in this account.
8. If any, part/parts need to be taken out from CPCB premises for repair/replacement, written permission (Gate Pass) should be taken from this office. No transportation charges will be paid on this account.
9. All the precautionary measures should be adopted for safety purposes during the contract period for carrying out the work. If any accident/mishap occurs during the contract period at site, the firm will be responsible for the same.
10. If you fail to render satisfactory services, the contract awarded to you shall be cancelled by giving 15 days notice without assigning any reasons whatsoever and the payment due if any, shall be forfeited. In this connection, decision of Chairmen, Central Pollution Control Board shall be final and binding both the parties.
11. The work should be done under the supervision and satisfaction of Building Division, Central Pollution Control Board.
12. All the general and special tools, required for work shall be arranged by you at your own cost.
13. The rates are inclusive of all taxes, labour, transportation etc, no other charges will be made in this account.
14. The payment will be made on half yearly basis, after satisfactory completion of services in the half year period.
15. Income tax shall be deducted at source as applicable.
16. The work shall be carried out strictly according to CPWD specifications for electrical work.
17. It may be noted that mere quoting the lowest rates will not entitle any firm to get the work order.



3. The Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board reserves the right to cancel any or all the quotations without assigning any reasons thereof.
