REVIEW MEETING WITH PUBLIC AGENCIES & SPCBs ON DELHI NCR AIR QUALITY MINUTES OF MEETING – 12.02.2020

Review meeting with implementing agencies and SPCBs was held at CPCB on February 12, 2020 to review actions taken for controlling air pollution in Delhi. List of participants is annexed.

Sh. Aditya Sharma, IT Department, CPCB briefed about the current redressal status of the complaints lodged through SAMEER App and social media along with their resolution status based on feedback by CPCB field inspections. It was informed that the jurisdictional issues with Public Works Department (PWD), North Delhi Municipal Corporation, Delhi State Industrial and Infrastructure Development Corporation (DSIIDC) and Delhi Development Authority (DDA) are not resolved yet. It was also brought to knowledge that several agencies do not upload a valid photograph of the complaint resolution/ATR.

Sh. N.K. Gupta Addl. Director CPCB, apprised about the Comprehensive Action Plan and also took into consideration, the problems faced by agencies such as vague mention of location, and ban on C&D activities. It was also made aware that sprinkling of water on unpaved roads creates another problem of dust on roads.

Dr. Prashant Gargava, MS, CPCB joined the meeting during concluding session and he emphasized that actions to mitigate air pollution should continue with same vigour even after winter season, which will help in reducing annual average concentrations and increase more number of days with better air quality.

After due deliberations, following points were agreed upon:

- 1. Agencies which have not taken actions on air pollution complaints, shall immediately initiate the actions to resolve the complaints in a time bound manner.
- 2. Social media complaints may be addressed by agencies on daily basis and there should be zero pendency. There will be no tolerance to air polluting activities.
- 3. Status of complaint redressal and jurisdiction issues may be brought to the attention of the Chief Secretary, Delhi.
