Minutes of Forty Third meeting of Task Force on Graded Response Action Plan held on December 30, 2018

Forty Third meeting of Task Force on Graded Response Action Plan (GRAP) was convened on 30^{th} December, 2018, in view of increase in particulate matter concentration during last night, with PM_{2.5} levels remaining above $300\mu\text{g/m}^3$ since 9:00 AM today. The meeting was headed by the Member Secretary, CPCB. The list of participants is annexed.

IMD and SAFAR informed that air quality may improve slightly by 31st December, but is likely to remain in 'severe' category owing to low wind speed and ventilation coefficient which are highly unfavourable for dispersion of pollutants. There may be some relief due to westerly disturbance, but dense to moderate fog and emissions during night hours may result in deterioration in air quality. The situation may prevail till 2nd January.

Task Force reviewed the status and recommended that while measures already in force must continue, the enforcement on ground needs to be stepped up particularly in hot spot areas. The implementing agencies in Delhi and four neighbouring townsof Noida, Ghaziabad, Faridabad and Gurugram to be on high alert, carry out night patrolling, and take actions with zero tolerance to waste burning and construction activities (that is already banned during night hours). Agencies must also ensure strict compliance to the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court regarding bursting of firecrackers.
