**Status of the Project on “Remediation of hazardous waste contaminated
dumpsites under National Clean Energy Fund (NCEF) Project”**

- CPCB had called EoIs for the phase-I consultants i.e. preparation of Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) and providing consultancy services for remediation of aforesaid 10 contaminated areas. In response, 16 National/international consultants had submitted their EoIs.
- RFPs were issued to 16 shortlisted consultants on 21/06/2013 with last date for proposal submission as 07/08/2013.
- Held pre-bid meeting with the shortlisted consultants on 09/07/2013.
- Clarifications on RFPs and amendments thereof were issued on 03/10/2013. The last date for submission of proposals was extended to 28/10/2013.
- The received proposals were opened on 29/10/2013.
- Technical evaluation was done by 04/12/2013.
- Financial proposal was open on 21/12/2013.
- M/s ERM India Private Limited, Gurgaon has been selected for “preparation of DPR and providing consultancy services for remediation of all 08 contaminated areas”.
- Pre-award of Technical Expert Committee (TEC) meeting was held on 24/02/2014 for finalization of approach and work plan for aforesaid NCEF project with M/s ERM India Private Limited, Gurgaon.
- Held technical negotiations with M./s ERM within the scope of ToR specified in RFP.
- External Consultant examined the project and draft contract document on 24/05/2014.
- Contracts signed for the following 08 contaminated areas between CPCB and M/s ERM India Private Limited, Gurgaon, during July, 2014.
 1. Mercury Contaminated sites at Gunjam, Orissa
 2. Chromium Contaminated area, Orichem, Talcher, Orissa
 3. Chromium Contaminated area at Rania, Kanpur Dehat, Uttar Pradesh
 4. Pesticide contaminated site near Deva Road, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh
 5. Chromium Contaminated Area at Ranipet, Tamil Nadu
 6. H-Acid Contaminated Sites near Ratlam, Madhya Pradesh
 7. Chromium and heavy Metal contaminated Area at Nibra, Howrah, WB
 8. Pesticides Contaminated land and creeks near Eloor-Edayar, Kerala

- Site visits and kick-off meetings for all 08 contaminated areas were held in the month of September, 2014.
- Step-1 and 2 of the Project i.e. Reconnaissance and Preliminary Investigations for all 08 contaminated areas have been started.
