Hon'ble NGT orders in the matter of O.A. No. 1038/2018 (CEPI matter)-Action Plans for the polluted industrial areas identified as CPAs/SPAs

Sir,

This has reference to Hon'ble NGT order, dated 13.12.2018, in the matter of O.A. No. 1038/2018, directing SPCBs/PCCs to finalise time bound action plans with regard to the identified polluted industrial clusters. In this regard, APPCB has submitted the action plan for Vijayawada Industrial Cluster (categorised as SPA), vide letter No. APPCB/UH-IV/CEPI/2020-1872, dated, 27.01.2020. The Central Board, after looking into the action plan, suggests the following views/recommendations for consideration and incorporation in the action plan:

- Action points for management of municipal solid wastes.
- Action points for compliance of CETPs.
- Action points of TPP for compliance of emission norms and 100% recirculation of ash pond overflow.
- To ensure traffic management and roads for ash and LPG transportation.
- Carrying out source apportionment study for further planning of pollution control.

It is requested to modify the action plan accordingly, and upload the same at APPCB's website. The progress of implementation of action plan should be reviewed quarterly by the concerned Committees constituted for this purpose and the status report should be uploaded at APPCB's website.

It is further requested to provide a hard copy and also a soft copy of revised action plan to the Central Board.
