

Sir,

This has reference to the Hon'ble NGT order, dated 13.12.2019, in the matter of O.A. No. 1038/2018, directing SPCBs/PCCs to finalize the time bound action plans with regard to the identified polluted industrial clusters. In this regard, Rajasthan SPCB has submitted action plan for Pali (categorized as CPA), Jodhpur (categorized as CPA), Bhiwadi (categorized as CPA), vide letter dated 20.8.2020. The Central Pollution Control following the action plans, suggests the Board, after looking into views/recommendations for consideration and incorporation in the action plans:

- Providing constitution of the committee approved by Chief Secretary of Rajasthan and signed action plans by the committee members.
- Establishing CAAQMS as per the directions issued by CPCB vide letter dated 26.4.2016 and connectivity to CPCB server.
- Providing timelines in terms of month and year for short term/long term targets.
- Providing action plan for restoration of polluted water bodies/contaminated sites.
- Considering source inventory/apportionment study for further planning of pollution control.
- Providing additional CAAQMS in Bhiwadi industrial area and connectivity to CPCB server.
- Carrying out surface water and groundwater samples and analysing the parameters w.r.t. chemicals of concern, heavy metals and general parameters.



It is requested to modify the action plans accordingly, and upload the same at website of Rajasthan SPCB. The progress of implementation of action plans should be reviewed quarterly by the concerned Committees constituted for this purpose and the progress reports should be uploaded at the website.

It is further requested to provide a hard copy and also a soft copy of revised action plans to CPCB.
