In this regard, UPPCB has submitted action plans for Agra, Bulandshahar-Khurja, Firozabad, Gajraula, Ghaziabad, Kanpur, Moradabad, Noida & Singrauli, vide email dated 20.01.2021. The Central Pollution Control Board after looking into the action plans, suggests views/recommendations, provided at *Annexure-I*, for consideration and incorporation in the action plans.

It is requested to modify the action plan accordingly, and uploadthe same at the website of UPPCB. The progress of implementation of action plan should be reviewed quarterly by the concerned Committees constituted for the purpose and the status report should be uploaded at the website.

Gajraula:

- Providing the measures for control of water pollution also, as the action plan covers the measures for control of air pollution only.
- Providing map showing the demarcation of boundaries, clearly, of core area and also the impact area i.e. 5 km from the boundaries of core area.

Ghaziabad:

- The boundaries of six industrial sub-clusters are required to be demarcated and area of each sub-cluster be provided separately.
- Providing the action points with timelines for establishment of STPs and MSW facilities.

Bulandshahar-Khurja:

- The demarcation of PIA consists of UPSIDC industrial area, Sikandrabad and Khurja. Action plan does not cover action points for Sikandrabad.
- Providing the action points with timelines for establishment of STPs and MSW facilities.

Sir,

This has reference to the Hon'ble NGT order, dated 13.12.2019, in the matter of O.A. No. 1038/2018, directing SPCBs/PCCs to finalize the time bound action plans with regard to the identified polluted industrial clusters. In this regard, Gujarat SPCB has submitted action plan for Mathura (categorized as CPA), vide letter dated 20.8.2020. The Central Pollution Control Board, after looking into the action plans, suggests the following views/recommendations for consideration and incorporation in the action plans:

- Incorporating introduction, details of the area, sources of pollution, list of industries, demarcated industrial area map etc.,
- Action plans should cover pollution control of industrial sources along with other sources of pollution control.
- Providing points for controlling exceeding organic pollutants, nutrients and pesticides in surface water.
- Providing constitution of the committee approved by Chief Secretary of Uttar Pradesh and signed action plans by the committee members.
- Establishing online continuous water/ambient air quality monitoring stations as per the directions issued by CPCB vide letter dated 26.4.2016 and connectivity to CPCB server.
- Action taken/proposed for restoration of polluted water bodies/contaminated sites.
