Sub: Directions under Section 18(1)(b) of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 & the Air (Prevention And Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, in the matter of closure of industries which are operating in the residential and non confirming area, particularly the polluting industries.

WHEREAS under Section 17 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, one of the functions of the Delhi Pollution Control Committee, constituted under Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 is to plan a comprehensive programme for the Prevention, Control or Abatement of Water Pollution in the State of Delhi and to secure the execution thereof:

WHEREAS under Section 17 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, one of the functions of the Delhi Pollution Control Committee, constituted under Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 is to plan a comprehensive programme for the Prevention, Control or Abatement of Air Pollution in the State of Delhi and to secure the execution thereof:

WHEREAS, large number of polluting units operating in the residential and non confirming areas and discharging untreated effluent into the drains/sewer and creating nuisance and environmental problems to the residents.

WHEREAS Hon'ble National Green Tribunal (NGT) in the O.A No. 06 of 2012 in the matter of Manoj Mishra Vs Union of India and others passed the order dated May 19, 2017 that Delhi Jal Board would be entitled to get complete assistance from Delhi Pollution Control Committee, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) during execution of second phase of "Maily se Nirmal Yamuna Revatilization Project 2007".

WHEREAS Hon'ble NGT in the O.A No. 06 of 2012 in the matter of Manoj Mishra Vs Union of India and others passed the order dated May 19, 2017 for closure of the industries are which operating in the residential and non confirming area, particularly the polluting industries. Directions had already passed on behest of Govt. of NCT Delhi that such industries should be closed but it has been brought to notice to Hon'ble Tribunal that these industries are still operating and polluting drains very seriously.

WHEREAS Chief Engineer (Dr) Pr-II of Delhi Jal Board Govt. of NCT Delhi has requested vide letter No. F.67/DJB/CE(Dr) Pr-II/2017/370, dated 20/07/2017 to take necessary action in compliance of order dated May 19, 2017 of Hon'ble NGT in the O.A No. 06 of 2012 in the matter of Manoj Mishra Vs Union of India and others.

NOW, THEREFORE, in compliance of order dated May 19, 2017 of Hon'ble NGT in the O.A No. 06 of 2012 in the matter of Manoj Mishra Vs

Union of India and others, in exercise of powers conferred under section 18 (1) (b) of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, and Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 the following directions are issued to Delhi Pollution Control Committee for compliance.

1. Close all the industries which are operating in the residential and non confirming areas particularly the polluting industries which are discharging untreated trade effluent and polluting drains very seriously.

The Action Taken Report shall be submitted to the Central Pollution Control Board within 30 days from the date of receipt of these directions.
