DIRECTIONS UNDER SECTION 18(1) (b) OF THE WATER (PREVENTION AND CONTROL OF POLLUTION) ACT, 1974 FOR NON COMPLYING STPS AT SONIPAT, FARIDABAD AND GURUGRAM.

WHEREAS, amongst others, under Section 17 of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, one of the functions of the State Pollution Control Board (SPCB) constituted under the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 is to inspect sewage or trade effluent works and plants for the treatment of sewage and trade effluents and to review plans, specifications or other data relating to plants set up for the treatment of water / wastewater and the system for the disposal of sewage or trade effluents or in connection with the grant of any consent as required by this act; and

WHEREAS, CPCB has issued directions under section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to Public Health Engineering Department, Haryana for non-operational STPs at Rathdana, Sonapat vide letter dated 05/04/2019. PHED, Haryana submitted that aforesaid STPs have been handed over to Municipal Corporation, Sonapat and operated by Municipal Corporation Sonipat; and

WHEREAS, CPCB has issued directions under section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to Municipal Corporation Gurugram for non-Complying STPs at Dhanwapur Phase I, II and III vide letter dated 05/04/2019. Compliance of these directions is still awaited; and

WHEREAS, CPCB has issued directions under section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to Municipal Corporation Faridabad for non-Complying STPs at Badshapur Phase I, Phase II, Mirzapur and Pratapgarh vide letter dated 05/04/2019. Compliance of these directions is still awaited; and

WHEREAS, CPCB has monitored 15 STPs during the year 2019 (at Yamunanagar, Panipat, Sonapat, Gurugram and Faridabad). Out of 15 STPs (527.5 MLD), 07 STPs (219.5 MLD) were found non – operational [Sonapat (03 STPs-59.5 MLD), Faridabad (02 STPs-65MLD) and Ballabgarh (02 STPs-95MLD)] and 02 STPs (168 MLD) at Gurugram were found non-complying. Details of the STP monitoring are attached as Annexure. Out of 15 STPs of total installed capacity of 527.5 MLD, only 05 STPs (140 MLD) are observed as complying.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred under section 18 (1) (b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act 1974, the Chairman, Haryana State Pollution Control Board (HSPCB) is hereby directed as follows:

1. HSPCB shall issue directions to concerned authorities to ensure that sewage treatment plants are optimally operated so as to comply with the prescribed norms.

2. HSPCB shall direct the Local Municipal Bodies / State level Authorities to ensure that entire sewage generated at Yamunanagar, Panipat, Karnal, Sonapat, Gurugram and Faridabad and any other town located in the catchment area of river Yamuna, is conveyed to Sewage Treatment Plants (STPs) and these STPs are operated at the designed capacity and conform to the prescribed norms.

Action taken report shall be submitted by Haryana State Pollution Control Board (HSPCB) to CPCB within 30 days from the date of receipt of these directions along-with a time bound action plan for compliance of the directions. HSPCB shall also acknowledge the receipt of these directions to CPCB by return fax.
