**DIRECTIONS UNDER SECTION 18(1) (b) OF THE WATER (PREVENTION AND CONTROL OF POLLUTION) ACT, 1974 FOR ENSURING 100 % TREATMENT OF DOMESTIC AND INDUSTRIAL WASTEWATERS GENERATED FROM THE REGIONS OF SHAHIBABAD AND LONI , GHAZIABAD.**

WHEREAS, amongst others, under Section 17 of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, one of the functions of the State Pollution Control Board (SPCB) constituted under the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 is to inspect sewage or trade effluents works and plants for the treatment of sewage and trade effluents and to review plans, specifications or other data relating to plants set up for the treatment of water and wastewater and the system for the disposal of sewage or trade effluents or in connection with the grant of any consent as required by this act; and

WHEREAS, CPCB has issued directions vide letter dated 10.3.2016 under section 18(1)(b) of Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 to Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board for non-complying STPs operated at Ghaziabad. Compliance of these directions are still awaited; and

Whereas, CPCB has been monitoring water quality of Shahibabad and Inderpuri Drain on monthly basis. Inderpuri drain carries partially treated and untreated domestic and industrial wastewater of Loni town and merges with Shahdara drain in Delhi. Similarly, Shahibabad drain carries partially treated and untreated domestic and industrial wastewaters of Shahibabad and merges with Shahdara drain in Delhi; and

**WHEREAS**, Water Quality data of Shahibabad and Inderpuri drain for the month of November, 2020 are as follows:

Drain	Flow (m <sup>3</sup> /sec)	pH	TSS (mg/l)	COD (mg/l)	BOD (mg/l)
Inderpuri drain	0.21	7.5	693	1120	302
Shahibabad Drain	0.40	7.6	400	778	266

Water quality data of above drain reveals the value of COD as more than 700 mg/l which depicts that it carries partially treated / untreated industrial effluent in addition to domestic wastewater.


**NOW, THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers conferred under section 18 (1) (b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act 1974, Chairman , Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board (UPPCB) is hereby directed as follows:

1. UPPCB shall issue directions to concerned authorities namely UP Jal Nigam and Ghaziabad Development Authority to ensure that sewage treatment plants are optimally operated so as to comply with the prescribed norms.
2. UPPCB shall direct the Local Municipal Bodies / State level Authorities to ensure that entire sewage generated at Ghaziabad is conveyed to Sewage Treatment Plants (STPs) and these STPs are operated at the designed capacity and conforms to the prescribed norms.

3. UPPCB shall ensure that all industrial units in Shahibabad and Loni town shall have Effluent Treatment Plants of adequate capacities and shall not discharge any untreated/partially treated effluent into any drain.


The action taken report shall be submitted by Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board (UPPCB) to CPCB within 30 days from the date of receipt of these directions alongwith a time bound action plan for compliance of the directions. UPPCB shall also acknowledge the receipt of these directions to CPCB by return fax.
