Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 - Revoke reg.

WHEREAS, the Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Allied Leather Finishers Pvt. Ltd. F-27/28, Site-2 Industrial Area, DahiChowk, Unnao(hereafter referred as the Unit), is a tannery engaged in processing of wet blue to produce finished leather; and

WHEREAS, the unit was inspected on 26.05.2017 by CPCB officials and the following observations were made:

- (i) The unit was found non-complying the effluent discharge standards w.r.t. TSS 152 mg/l (norms 600 mg/l), BOD 214 mg/l (norms 30 mg/l) and Total Chromium 2.4 mg/l (norms 2.0 mg/l).
- (ii) Stack height of DG sets inadequate.
- (iii) Not having NOC from CGWA.
- (iv) OCEMS was found installed and is connected with CPCB server.

AND WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure direction dated 17.08.2017 to the unit to close all operations till the compliance of following directions:

- (i) To take corrective measures for upgradation and proper orientation and maintenance of ETP so that the quality of the treated effluent from ETP out meets the prescribed discharge standards.
- (ii) To repair the pump installed for lifting of treated effluent to online analysers and maintain the online monitoring system properly so as to minimise the difference between online and laboratory data.
- (iii) To provide adequate stack height to DG sets.
- (iv) To maintain proper log book for HW/solid waste generation and disposal.
- (v) To obtain NOC from CGWA for ground water abstraction.

WHWREAS, the unit was inspected on 29.11.2017 in response to the public complaint and the unit was found not in operation on the date of inspection.

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AND WHEREAS, the unit replies vide letters dated: 18.09.2017, 06.11.2017, 27.11.2017, 01.12.2017 and 15.01.2018 were examined and following observations are made-

- (i) The unit has installed Chrome Recovery Plant as corrective measure for up-gradation.
- (ii) The pump installed for lifting of treated effluent to on-line analysers has been repaired and re-installed.
- (iii) Stack height of the DG sets has been increased to 22 feet above the roof level.
- (iv) 24 hours manning of ETP plant has been started for proper operation, maintenance and monitoring of quality of the treated effluent from ETP as per prescribed discharge standards.
- (v) Copy of the application to UPPCB dated 26.12.2017 to obtain NOC from CGWA for ground water abstraction provided.

WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three Member Committee vide office order dated 19.01.2018 having representative from CPCB, MoEF&CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 19.01.2018 examined the replies dated: 18.09.2017, 06.11.2017, 27.11.2017, 01.12.2017 and 15.01.2018 and recommended for the revoke of closure direction with the following conditions: -

- (i) The unit is recommended for revocation with condition of valid CTO and HWA.
- (ii) The unit shall ensure that treated effluent discharged by the Unit will always comply the ETP standards as per Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, applicable to standalone tannery / as per the consent issued by the UPPCB.

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above mentioned observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman CPCB, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the closure direction dated 17.08.2017 is hereby revoked and the Unit M/s Allied Leather Finishers Pvt. Ltd. F-27/28, Site-2 Industrial Area, Dahi Chowk, Unnao is directed to comply with the following:

- (i) The unit shall remain closed and shall resume operation after obtaining consent to operate under Water Act and submit a copy of CTO to CPCB.
- (ii) The unit shall inform immediately to CPCB on resumption of manufacturing operation.
- (iii) The unit shall ensure that treated effluent discharged by the Unit will always comply the ETP standards as per Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, applicable to standalone tannery / as per the consent issued by the UPPCB.
- (iv) The unit shall maintain log book for hazardous waste/chromium sludge disposal.
- (v) The unit shall submit analysis result of the treated effluent on daily basis for one month from laboratory recognized under Environment (Protection) Act 1986, within 45 days from the date of resumption of operation.
- (vi) The unit shall always ensure data transmission to CPCB server.

In case of failure of compliance with the above directions CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
