**Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 - Revoke reg.**

**WHEREAS**, the Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, M/s Alig Tannery A-25, LTP, UPSIDC, Banthar, Unnao, UP (hereafter referred as the Unit), is a tannery engaged in processing of raw hides to wet blue; and

**WHEREAS**, the unit was inspected on 12.04.2017, by the team deputed by CPCB and made the following observations: -

- (i) During the inspection the unit was found closed.

**AND WHEREAS**, CPCB issued closure direction dated 28.06.2017 and directed the unit to comply with the following-

- (i) The unit shall remain closed till it has adequate arrangements for treating effluent, installs & connects online effluent monitoring system and possesses valid consent.  
(ii) The unit shall seek permission from CPCB before resumption of manufacturing operation.

**AND WHEREAS**, the unit replies vide letters dated 15.11.2017, 06.12.2017, 18.12.2017 & 27.12.2017 were examined and following observations are made-

- (i) The unit has installed OCEMS (online flow meter) and provided the connectivity with CPCB sever.  
(ii) The unit has provided Self Certificate (in original).  
(iii) The unit has provided application copy of consent to operate under Water Act.  
(iv) The unit has installed filter press and submitted photographs of the same.  
(v) The unit has provided copy of authorization under HWM having validity upto 24.10.2018; and

**WHEREAS**, CPCB constituted a Three-member committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF & CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

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**WHEREAS**, the Three-member committee in its meeting held on 19.01.2018 examined the replies dated 15.11.2017, 06.12.2017, 18.12.2017 & 27.12.2017 and recommended for the revoke of closure direction with the following condition:

- (i) The unit shall submit the daily analysis lab report from EPA laboratory for one month.

**NOW THEREFORE**, in view of the above mentioned observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman CPCB, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the Unit, M/s Alig Tannery A-25, LTP, UPSIDC, Banthar, Unnao (UP) is directed to comply with the following:

- (i) The unit shall remain closed and shall resume operation only after obtaining valid consent to operate under Water Air Acts from UPPCB.
- (ii) The unit shall inform immediately to CPCB, on resumption of manufacturing operations.
- (iii) The unit shall provide valid consent to operate (CTO) under Water Act and Air Act within 30 days from the date of receipt.
- (iv) The unit shall take necessary action to ensure that primary treated effluent discharged by the unit will always comply the PETP standards prescribed by UPPCB / inlet to CETP standards and ensure that PETP effluent is treated in the CETP.
- (v) The unit shall submit daily analysis result of the treated effluent for one month from laboratory recognized under Environment (Protection) Act 1986, within 45 days from the date of resumption of manufacturing operation.

In case of failure of compliance with the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
