**Direction issued under section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act 1986- Revoke reg.**

**WHEREAS**, the Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, M/s Super House Leather Limited (Unit-II), 102/88(10) A, 150 Feet Road, Jajmau, Kanpur, UP (here in after referred as the Unit), was inspected on 06.04.2017, by the team of officials deputed by CPCB and the following observations were made:

- (i) The unit has consent capacity to manufacture 4000 pieces of shoe upper through dry process.
- (ii) The unit was operational on the day of visit and the unit does not have tannery or PETP components.
- (iii) The unit has been operating without having valid consents and authorization since 01.01.2017, however, the unit has applied for renewal.

**AND WHEREAS**, CBCB issued show cause notice dated 15.06.2017, under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; to the Unit; and

**WHEREAS**, the unit replies vide letters dated 15.07.2017 and 29.08.2017 were examined and the following observations are made:

- (i) The unit has submitted copy of the consent to operate, having validity up to 31.12.2017.
- (ii) The unit is using water for domestic purpose and hence has not provided effluent analysis report.

**NOW THEREFORE**, in view of the above and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act 1986, the show cause notice dated 15.06.2017 is hereby revoked and M/s Super House Leather Limited (Unit-II), 102/88(10) A, 150 Feet Road, Jajmau, Kanpur, UP is directed to comply with the following:

- (i) The unit shall continue with dry manufacturing operations and in no case trade effluent shall be generated.
- (ii) The unit shall provide a copy of valid consent to operate to CPCB within 30 days from the date of receipt of these directions.

In case of failure of compliance with the above directions CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
