SHOW CAUSE DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Govt. of India, vide notification S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 has delegated powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), to issue direction to any industry, Municipal Corporation, Municipal Council, Cantonment Board to any local or other Authority for the violation of emission and effluent standards notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and other standards and norms; and

WHEREAS, the M/s. India Frozen Foods, Begampur, Chimiawali Sambal, Uttar Pradesh (hereafter referred to as the 'Unit') involved in export of Bone less Buffalo meat having its own slaughtering facility.

WHEREAS, joint team of officials from the CPCB and UPPCB inspected the unit on 15.09.2015 and based on the observations CPCB was issued direction under section 5 of the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986 dated 12.02.2016 for upgradation of ETP and installation and connectivity of OCEMS.

WHEREAS, the Unit was inspected by CPCB on 24.01.2018 based on SMS alert generated with respect to offline of OCEMS data for more than 30 days and following observations are made:

1. The unit was found in operational during the visit (both processing/ production and ETP).
2. During the inspection, the OCEMS was found operational and connected with CPCB portal.
3. The unit has NOC from CGWA for fresh water extraction.
4. The unit has installed flow measuring devices at tube well and outlet of ETP.
5. Sample is collected from outlet of ETP and shows COD 253mg/l against norms of 250mg/l, BOD 99mg/l against norms of 30mg/l and TDS 2820mg/l against norms of 2100mg/l which indicate non-compliance with prescribed discharge standards.

It is evident that untreated/ partially treated effluent is being discharged on land by the unit, posing potential threat to surface water/ groundwater quality.

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AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, a notice is hereby served to show cause why the M/s. India Frozen Foods, Begampur, Chimiawali Sambal, Uttar Pradesh, should not be closed down for discharging untreated/ partially treated effluent.

You are hereby given an opportunity to file your objections (if any) to the above proposed directions within 15 days from the receipt of this notice, failing which appropriate action will be taken against the Unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
