Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 regarding installation of on-line effluent and emission monitoring system-reg

WHEREAS, the Pharmaceutical industries are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, M/s. Enaltec Labs Pvt. Ltd, Maharashtra (herein after referred to as the Unit) which comes under pharmaceutical category, has installed the Online continuous effluent Monitoring system (OCEMS) for the parameters pH and Flow, however the Unit is sending the effluent to CETP; and

WHEREAS, it was observed by the IT division of the CPCB that the Online continuous effluent Monitoring system (OCEMS) was in offline mode during the month of 15 April - 15 May 2017; and

WHEREAS the Unit was inspected by a team of official(s) from the CPCB Regional Directorate, Vadodara on August 09, 2017 to assess the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures and online effluent monitoring system, observations of team are as follows:

1. The Unit was closed in response to the MPCB closure direction dated July 07, 2017.
2. The Unit has consent under the Water Act, 1974 & the Air Act, 1981 which was expired on April 30, 2017 from MPCB.
3. The Unit is a member of CETP, however online web camera has not been installed at the Effluent Treatment Plant (ETP).

WHEREAS, the Unit has not provided the online data connectivity of the web camera to the CPCB as per the verification report of the IT division of the CPCB dated September 04, 2017; and

WHEREAS, a closure direction was issued to the Unit vide letter dated September 22, 2017 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, as the following:

1. The Unit shall not to restart plant operation till online effluent monitoring system are install at effluent outlets (flow meter & camera for units sending effluent to CETP/zero liquid discharge units) and provide the connectivity to CPCB.
2. The Unit shall not to restart the plant operation till the permission to restart operation is obtained from the CPCB.
3. The Unit shall obtain valid Consent under the Water Act 1974, the Air Act 1981 and authorization under hazardous waste rules from the MPCB, and

WHEREAS, the Unit through email dated January 28, 2018 submitted the compliance against the closure direction dated September 22, 2017 and requested to revoke the closure direction; and

WHEREAS, the Unit has submitted an undertaking dated October 23, 2017 that "the Unit has complied with all directions issued by CPCB and if plant is found non-compliant during

verification by CPCB officials, the Unit accept to close down operations immediately and shall not operate till full compliance is achieved; and



WHEREAS, the Unit has submitted third party analysis report of ETP outlet effluent and Air Emission monitoring results through email dated February 20, 2018 from Sadekar Enviro Engineers Pvt. Ltd., Maharashtra (recognised by MoEF) and the results are found within the norms prescribed by Maharashtra Pollution Control Board w.r.t parameters pH, BOD, COD & TSS;

WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-member committee vide office order dated 03.10.2017 having representative(s) from CPCB and MoEF&CC for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the Three member committee in its meeting held on February 21, 2018 examined the compliance report submitted by the Unit and recommended that the Unit may be allowed to resume operation with condition that the Unit shall submit one month daily analysis report of treated effluent from the date of resumption of its operation from MoEF&CC recognised Lab; and


WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of powers vested to Chairman CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and in view of undertaking of compliance submitted by the Unit with relevant direction under reference, the direction issued under the Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the Unit (M/s. Enaltec Labs Pvt. Ltd, Maharashtra) vide letter dated September 22, 2017 is hereby revoked with condition that the Unit shall submit for one month daily analysis report of treated effluent, from the date of resumption of its operation from MoEF&CC recognised Lab. The Unit will ensure compliance with the norms. In case of non-compliance by the Unit action as deemed fit under the provisions of Environment (P) Act, 1986 shall be taken.
