Direction issued under section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act 1986- reg. Revoke

WHEREAS, the Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Saira Tanning Industries, 35-A, 150 Feet Road, Jajmau, Kanpur, UP (here in after referred as the Unit), is a tannery engaged in processing of raw hides to produce finished leather; and

WHEREAS, the unit was inspected on 27.03.2017 by the team deputed by CPCB and the following observation was made:

- (i) The unit was not complying with notified PETP effluent discharge standards w.r.t. TSS 2540 mg/l (against norms of 600 mg/l).

AND WHEREAS, CBCB issued closure direction dated 13.06.2017, under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; to the Unit till compliance of following direction:

- (i) The unit shall upgraded / properly operate the primary effluent treatment plant so as to achieve the notified standards;

AND WHEREAS, the unit was inspected on 01.08.2017, by the team of CPCB officials and the following observations were made:

- (i) The unit was found operational in violation of the closure direction dated 13.06.2017
- (ii) The unit has consent issued under Water Act with validity till 31.12.2017
- (iii) The analysis results of the samples taken from CETP conveyance channel showed pH-5.6 (against prescribed norms of 6.5-9.0), and Total Chromium – 104 mg/l (against prescribed norms of 2.0 mg/l) which indicate non-compliance w.r.t prescribed norms of pH & Total Chromium.

AND WHEREAS, CBCB issued closure direction dated 28.11.2017, under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; to the Unit till compliance of following:

- (i) The unit shall comply with the directions dated 13.06.2017.
- (ii) The unit shall upgrade/ properly operate its PETP to meet the prescribed norms; and

AND WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three Member Committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF&CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revoke of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the Unit replies vide letters dated 11.07.2017, 24.07.2017, 05.09.2017, 29.09.2017, 04.12.2017 & 29.01.2018 were examined and following observations are made:

- (i) The unit has installed screens and constructed extra tank for collection of chrome liquor.
- (ii) The unit has submitted self-certificate and Affidavit as per CPCB requirement.
- (iii) The unit has provided a fresh adequacy report from National Productivity Council (NPC).
- (iv) The unit has provided application copies of CTO under Air and Water acts.
- (v) The unit has submitted a valid copy of authorization for HWM.

AND WHEREAS, the Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 27.02.2018 examined the replies vide letters dated: 11.07.2017, 24.07.2017, 05.09.2017, 29.09.2017, 04.12.2017 & 29.01.2018 and recommended for revoke with the following conditions:

- (i) The adequacy report states that PETP system is adequate but inspection report reflects higher value of Chromium, so unit should be accountable for functioning of ETP.
- (ii) The unit recommended for revocation subject to frequent inspection by CPCB and valid consent to operate.
- (iii) Daily analysis report of effluent be submitted for one month.

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act 1986, closure directions dated 13.06.2017 & 28.11.2017 are hereby revoked and M/s Saira Tanning Industries, 35-A, 150 Feet Road, Jajmau, Kanpur, UP, is directed to comply with the following:

- (i) The unit shall resume manufacturing operation only after obtaining valid consent to operate under Water / Air Acts from UPPCB.
- (ii) The unit shall inform immediately to CPCB, on resumption of manufacturing operations.
- (iii) The unit shall take necessary action to ensure that primary treated effluent discharged by the Unit will always comply the PETP standards prescribed by UPPCB / inlet to CETP standards and ensure that PETP effluent is treated into the CETP.
- (iv) The unit shall provide valid consent to operate.
- (v) The unit shall maintain log book for hazardous waste/chromium sludge disposal.
- (vi) The unit shall submit analysis result of the treated effluent on daily basis for one month from laboratory recognized under Environment (Protection) Act 1986, within 45 days from the date of resumption of operation.
- (vii) The unit shall always ensure data transmission to CPCB server.

In case of failure of compliance with the above directions, the CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
