Direction issued under section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act 1986- reg. Revoke

WHEREAS, the Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Sahara Tanning Industries 104-C1, Wajidpur, Jajmau, Kanpur, UP (here in after referred as the Unit), is a tannery engaged in processing of raw hides to produce finished leather; and

WHEREAS, the unit was inspected on 23.03.2017 by the team deputed by CPCB and the following observations were made:

- (i) The unit has valid Consent under Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, up to 31.12.2017, however, no information provided regarding Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution), Act, 1981 and authorization under the Hazardous and other Wastes (Management and Trans boundary Movement) Rules, 2016. It is observed that hazardous waste generated from the said unit is sent to TSDF.
- (ii) The analysis report of treated effluent sample showed; pH -8.2 (as against 6.5-9.0), TSS-1220 mg/l (as against 600 mg/l), BOD-680 mg/l, O& G-23 mg/l, S-7.8 mg/l, and Cr (T)- 1.63 mg/l (as against 2 mg/L), which indicates non-compliance with the prescribed effluent discharge norms. The unit has not obtained NOC from CGWA for groundwater extraction.
- (iii) The unit has installed all the systems required for OCEMS and also provided the connectivity of OCEMS to CPCB server. However, the unit registration at CPCB was incomplete regarding OCEMS.

AND WHEREAS, CBCB issued closure direction dated 16.06.2017, under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; to the Unit for non-compliance with the prescribed effluent discharge norms; and

WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three Member Committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF&CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revoke of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

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WHEREAS, the Unit replies vide letters dated 11.07.2017, 28.08.2017, 15.09.2017, 30.10.2017, 08.12.2017, 09.01.2018 & 20.01.2018 were examined and following observations are made:

- (i) The unit has completed registration at CPCB server.
- (ii) The unit has submitted self-certificate and affidavit as per required format
- (iii) The unit has provided application copy of consent to operate under Water Act and Air Act having validity up to 31.12.2017.
- (iv) The unit has submitted a valid copy of authorization for HWM having validity up to 16.11.2022.
- (v) The unit has installed screen and filter press and provided photographs of the same.

AND WHEREAS, the Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 27.02.2018 examined the replies vide letters dated: 11.07.2017, 28.08.2017, 15.09.2017, 30.10.2017, 08.12.2017, 09.01.2018 & 20.01.2018 and recommended for revoke with the following conditions:

- (i) One-month effluent analysis report on daily basis to be submitted.
- (ii) Valid CTO to be submitted.
- (iii) Performance audit report of effluent treatment system from IIT be submitted within 45 days of operation.

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act 1986, the Unit M/s Sahara Tanning Industries 104-C1, Wajidpur Jajmau, Kanpur UP, is directed to comply with the following:

- (i) The unit shall resume manufacturing operation only after obtaining valid consent to operate under Water / Air Acts from UPPCB.
- (ii) The unit shall inform immediately to CPCB, on resumption of manufacturing operations.
- (iii) The unit shall take necessary action to ensure that primary treated effluent discharged by the Unit will always comply the PETP standards prescribed by UPPCB / inlet to CETP standards and ensure that PETP effluent is treated into the CETP.
- (iv) The unit shall provide to CPCB, copy of the valid consent to operate.
- (v) The unit shall maintain log book for hazardous waste/chromium sludge disposal.
- (vi) The unit shall submit analysis result of the treated effluent on daily basis for one month from laboratory recognized under Environment (Protection) Act 1986, within 45 days from the date of resumption of operation.
- (vii) The unit shall always ensure data transmission to CPCB server.
- (viii) The unit shall submit PETP performance audit report from IITs within 45 days of resumption of operation to CPCB

In case of failure of compliance with the above directions, the CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
