Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 –reg.

WHEREAS, the Textile dyeing and bleaching industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the general discharge standards of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under;

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Shatabdi Synthetics Pvt. Ltd., C-22-23, UPSIDC Indl. Area, Rooma, Kanpur (here in after referred as 'the unit') is a textile processing unit; and

WHEREAS, inspection of the unit was conducted on November 1st, 2017 by a team deputed by CPCB to check the status of compliance of prescribed norms and the following observations were made:


- 1) The unit was found operational during the inspection.
- 2) The unit was involved in dry work only at the time of inspection and the ETP was not operational.
- 3) The unit has applied for consents from UPPCB under Water and Air acts and also for hazardous waste authorization.
- 4) The unit has one borewell but does not maintain a logbook.
- 5) The unit has installed electromagnetic flowmeter at the outlet which is connected to the CPCB server.
- 6) The unit has installed a collection tank, equalization tank, chemical dosing tank, flocculator, tube settler, dual media filter and sludge drying beds. The unit is also a member of CETP.
- 7) The CETP to which the unit is connected is under stabilization.

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit, **M/s Shatabdi Synthetics Pvt. Ltd., C-22-23, UPSIDC Indl. Area, Rooma, Kanpur** is hereby directed to comply with the following directions.

1. The unit shall carry out only dry operations only till valid consents are obtained from UPPCB under Water/ Air Acts.
2. The primary treated effluent shall be conveyed to CETP for further treatment and to ensure that CETP outlet shall meet the prescribed standards after obtaining the consent.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions CPCB may initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
