DIRECTIONS UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986

WHEREAS, central Government has notified standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under Rule 3 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; and **WHEREAS**, all industries are required to install and regularly operate the requisite pollution control facilities to comply with the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; and

WHEREAS, Textile dyeing and bleaching industries are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality and;

WHEREAS, representatives of CPCB carried out inspection of **M/s. Muskan Dyeing, Nai Basti, Naugawan Sadat, Amroha- 244251 UP** (hereafter referred as Unit), on April 14, 2017 for verification of compliance to the norms stipulated under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure direction dated 15.05.2017 and 01.06.2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit; and

WHEREAS, the unit replies vide letter dated Nil was examined and following observations made:

1. The unit has applied for consent to operate to UPPCB.
2. The unit has installed OCEMS and connected to the CPCB server.
3. The unit has disposed ETP sludge through TSDF authorized company.

AND WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a three-member committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF & CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the three member committee in its meeting held on 21.02.2018 examined the reply of the Unit and recommended that (i) the Unit may be allowed to resume operation after obtaining valid consent to operate (ii) the unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report from laboratory recognized under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 within 45 days of resumption of operations and (iii) compliance verification by UPPCB within 60 days of operation of the unit; and

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above mentioned observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman CPCB, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit is hereby revoked and directed to comply with the following direction:

1. The Unit shall resume operation after obtaining valid consent to operate under Water Act and Air Act from Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board and shall treat their effluent to meet the effluent discharge standards as notified under Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986.
2. The Unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report from laboratory recognized under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 within 45 days of resumption of operations

3. The Unit **M/s. Muskan Dyeing, Nai Basti, Naugawan Sadat, Amroha- 244251 UP** shall ensure continuous connectivity with CPCB server.
4. The Unit shall immediately inform to CPCB regarding the resumption of operations.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate action without any further notice, in accordance with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.


