Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986

WHEREAS, the Textile dyeing and bleaching industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the general discharge standards of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under;

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Ganga Knit Fab, C-98, Rooma Industrial Area, Kanpur (U.P.) (here in after referred as 'the unit') is involved in the process of textile, dyeing & printing; and.

WHEREAS, inspection of the unit was conducted on April 21<sup>st</sup>, 2017 to check the status of compliance of prescribed norms; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure directions dated 15th May, 2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 for compliance of the following directions:

1. The unit shall stop all wet process operations immediately till installation and commissioning of online continuous effluent monitoring system (OCEMS) and provide connectivity to the CPCB server for continuous 24X7 data transmission.
2. The unit shall report to CPCB about stopping of wet process operations immediately.
3. The unit shall seek permission before resumption of wet process operation.

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**AND WHEREAS**, CPCB issued closure directions dated June 28th, 2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 for compliance of the following directions:

1. The unit shall remain closed till it has adequate arrangements for treating effluent, installs & connects online effluent monitoring system and possesses valid consent.
2. The unit shall seek permission from CPCB before resumption of manufacturing operation.

**WHEREAS**, the unit has replied vide letter dated June 17th, 2017 and 11th July, 2017 are examined and following observations are made:

1. The unit has installed ETP plant comprising of Equalization tank, aeration tank, reaction tank, tube settler, sludge bed and dual media filter.
2. The unit has applied to UPPCB for further consent.
3. The unit has connected its Online Continuous Effluent Monitoring System (OCEMS) with CPCB server.
4. The unit has also submitted self certificate and undertaking for compliance of CPCB directions.

**WHEREAS**, CPCB constituted a Three-Member Committee vide office order dated 27/09/2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF& CC & NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

**WHEREAS**, the Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 21<sup>st</sup> February, 2018 examined the replies dated 21.11.2017, 01.01.2018, 08.02.2018 and 15.02.2018 and recommended that:

1. Conditional revoke of the closure directions may be issued for obtaining valid consent with increased capacity;
2. Treated effluent analysis report to be provided within 45 days of resuming operation;
3. Compliance verification of the unit may be carried out by the State Pollution Control Board within 60 days.

**AND NOW, THEREFORE**, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit, **M/s Ganga Knit Fab, C-98, ROOMA Industrial Area, Kanpur (U.P.)** is hereby issued conditional revoke directions as follows:

1. The unit shall resume operation only after obtaining valid consent with increased capacity from UPPCB and shall inform to CPCB about date of resumption of operation immediately.

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2. The unit shall submit a treated effluent analysis report from Environmental laboratory recognized by Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, to CPCB within 45 days of resuming operation.
3. Compliance verification of directions shall be carried out by SPCB within 60 days of resuming operation.

In case of non-compliance of the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate action against the unit without giving any further notice in accordance with the provision of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
