**DIRECTIONS UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION)
ACT, 1986**

WHEREAS, Textile dyeing and bleaching industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly on land and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality and;

WHEREAS, A team of officials deputed from Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) inspected **M/s. J.P. Knitwears, S-9, Site-4 Panki Industrial Area, Kanpur- UP.** (herein after referred as the Unit) on April 15, 2017 to assess the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures and made following observations:

1. The Unit was closed and no representative from the Unit was available to contact.

AND WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure direction dated 15.05.2017 and 09.06.2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; and

WHEREAS, the unit replies vide letters dated 26.06.2017, 22.07.2017 and 27.11.2017 were examined and following observations are made:

1. The unit has submitted copy of consent to operate under Water Act issued form UPPCB with validity upto 31.12.2019 with modified discharge capacity 8 KLD.
2. The unit has installed OCEMS system for treated effluent monitoring and provided connectivity to CPCB server.
3. The unit has applied for consent to operate under Air Act.

WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a three-member committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF & CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the three member committee in its meeting held on 21.02.2018 examined the inspection report of the Unit and recommended that (i) the Unit may be allowed to resume operation and (ii) the unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report from laboratory recognized under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 within 45 days of resumption of operations and (iii) compliance verification within 60 days of resumption of operation; and

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above mentioned observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman CPCB, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the closure direction dated 15.05.2017 and 09.06.2017 are hereby revoked and the unit is directed to comply with the following direction:

1. The unit **M/s. J.P. Knitwears, S-9, Site-4 Panki Industrial Area, Kanpur- UP.** may resume operation and shall treat their effluent to meet the effluent discharge standards as notified under Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986.
2. The unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report from laboratory recognized under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 within 45 days of resumption of operations
3. The unit shall ensure continuous connectivity with CPCB server.
4. The Unit shall immediately inform to CPCB regarding the resumption of operations.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate action without any further notice, in accordance with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
