DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986- REG.

WHEREAS, Textile dyeing and bleaching industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly on land and into water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on land and the ambient water quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment Forests & Climate Change, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of emission and effluent standards notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/S Basotia Industries, C-16-17, Industrial Area, Site-IV, Panki, Kanpur, UP (hereafter referred as 'the Unit') is a Textile, dyeing Industry; and was inspected by third party team designated by CPCB on April 07, 2017 and following observations were made;

1. The Unit was found non-complying with respect to prescribed discharge standards as samples collected from outlet of ETP shows BOD: 50mg/l against 30 mg/l, Sulphide at 52mg/l against 2 mg/l, Oil & Grease 14mg /l as against 10 mg/l, and SAR value as 213 against notified standards of 26.
2. The Unit has no valid consent to operate though applied for renewal.

AND WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure direction dated 29.06.2017 to the Unit under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, to close all plant operations until the unit provides Action Taken Report to meet the discharge standards and obtain valid consent from UPPCB to operate the unit. The unit shall seek permission from CPCB before resumption of their manufacturing operations; and

WHEREAS, the unit's replies vide letters dated 19.12.2017 and 15.01.2018 were examined and following observations are made:

- i) The Unit has provided details of ETP up-gradation which include incorporation of new oil and grease trap, modification of equalization tank, installation of diffused air system of 2HP capacity, installation of new settling tank-3, installation of stirrer system for mixing of dosed chemicals in Primary Settling Tank & Secondary Settling Tank, installed new tube settler, installed new activated carbon filter and change of media in already installed pressure sand filter alongwith the photographs of the ETP system.
- ii) The Unit has installed online flow meter and provided connectivity with CPCB server
- iii) The consent to operate issued to the Unit, under Water and Air Act was valid upto 31.12.2015, and the Unit has applied for fresh consent to operate to Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board (UPPCB) at reduced discharge capacity request of total 9.0 KLD discharge.

AND WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a three-member committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF & CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the three member committee in its meeting held on 21.02.2018 examined the replies of the Unit and made the following recommendations (i) Conditional revoke to start operations only after obtaining valid consent to operate under Water Act and Air Act with reduced discharge capacity (<10KLD) from UPPCB; (ii)The Unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report, to CPCB within 45 days from the date of resumption of operations, from a laboratory recognized under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; (iii) Compliance

verification of the Unit will be done to verify the compliance of the Unit within 60 days of the resumption of operations by the State Pollution Control Board; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the following directions are issued to **M/s. Basotia Industries, C-16-17, Industrial Area, Site-IV, Panki, Kanpur-208020, UP** for compliance:


- 1) The Unit may resume manufacturing operations only after obtaining valid consent to operate under Water Act and Air Act with modified discharge capacity (<10KL per day) as per application submitted to UPPCB.
- 2) The Unit shall immediately inform to CPCB regarding the date of resumption of operations.
- 3) The Unit shall operate ETP properly so as to ensure with the effluent discharge norms notified under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
- 4) The Unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report, to CPCB within 45 days from the date of resumption of operations, from a laboratory recognized under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
- 5) The Unit shall ensure continuous connectivity of OCEMS system installed at the outlet of ETP with CPCB server.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the Unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
