Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986

WHEREAS, the Textile dyeing and bleaching industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the general discharge standards of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under;

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Manoj Dyers, Jamunipur, Bhadohi (U.P.) (here in after referred as 'the unit') is involved in the process of conversion of canvass cloth after dyeing into waterproof cloth; and

WHEREAS, inspection of the unit was conducted on 23rd March, 2018 to check the status of compliance of prescribed norms; and

WHEREAS, CPCB had issued the following directions dated May 15th, 2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit:

1. The unit shall stop all wet process operations till installation and commissioning of online continuous effluent monitoring system (OCEMS) and provide connectivity to the CPCB server for continuous 24 X 7 data transmission.
2. The unit shall report to CPCB about stopping of wet process operations immediately.
3. The unit shall seek permission from CPCB before resumption of wet process operation.

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WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure directions dated 18th May, 2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 for compliance of the following directions:

1. The unit, **M/s Manoj Dyers, Jamunipur, Bhadohi (U.P.)** shall close all the plant operations with immediate effect and shall not resume till the following are complied.
2. The unit shall upgrade and properly operate the effluent treatment plant efficiently so as to achieve the notified standards.
3. The unit shall obtain permission from Central Ground Water Authority for ground water extraction.
4. The unit shall install flow meters at the borewells, inlet and outlet of ETP.
5. The unit shall maintain log book for the water consumption.
6. The unit shall install OCEMS for online monitoring for effluent and provide connectivity to CPCB server.

WHEREAS, the unit replies vide letters dated 19th June,2017, 23rd August,2017, 30th October,2017, 30th November,2017, 4th January,2018 were examined and following observations are made:

1. The unit has installed flowmeter and connected it with CPCB server.
2. The unit has submitted an application to UPPCB to limit its discharge to 4 KLD.
3. The unit has modified its ETP and submitted photographs to CPCB.
4. The unit has applied for permission from Central Ground Water Authority.

WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-Member Committee vide office order dated 27/09/2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF& CC & NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 21st February,2018 examined the replies dated 19th June,2017, 23rd August,2017, 30th October,2017, 30th November,2017, 4th January,2018 and recommended that:

1. Conditional revoke of the closure directions may be issued for obtaining valid consent;
2. Treated effluent analysis report to be provided within 45 days of resuming operation; .
3. Compliance verification of the unit to be carried out by the State Pollution Control Board within 60 days of resumption of operation.

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AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit, M/s Manoj Dyers, Jamunipur, Bhadohi (U.P.) is hereby directed to comply with the following directions

1. The unit shall resume operation only after obtaining valid consent with reduced capacity (<10 kl/day) from UPPCB and shall inform to CPCB about date of resumption of operation immediately.
2. The unit shall submit a treated effluent analysis report from Environmental laboratory recognized by Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, to CPCB within 45 days of resuming operation.
3. The unit shall install flow meters at the borewells, inlet and outlet of ETP.
4. The unit shall maintain log book for the water consumption.

In case of non-compliance of the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate action against the unit without giving any further notice in accordance with the provision of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
