Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986

WHEREAS, the Textile dyeing and bleaching industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the general discharge standards of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under;

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Rama Tex Process House Pvt. Ltd., 93/2, Rithani, Delhi Road, Meerut (here in after referred as 'the unit') is involved in scouring, bleaching, washing, dyeing and finishing of grey cloth to dried cloth; and

WHEREAS, inspection of the unit was conducted on 3rd April, 2017 to check the status of compliance of prescribed norms; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure directions dated 15th May, 2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 for compliance of the following directions:

1. The unit shall stop all wet process operations immediately till installation and commissioning of online continuous effluent monitoring system (OCEMS) and provide connectivity to the CPCB server for continuous 24X7 data transmission.
2. The unit shall report to CPCB about stopping of wet process operations immediately.

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3. The unit shall seek permission before resumption of wet process operation.

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure directions dated 21st June, 2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 for compliance of the following directions:

- 1) The unit shall close down its all manufacturing operations with immediate effect.
- 2) The unit shall report to CPCB regarding closure of manufacturing operations in compliance of the direction immediately on receipt of the directions.
- 3) The unit shall install flow meter at the borewell and outlet of ETP.
- 4) The unit shall install and connect Online Continuous effluent Monitoring System (OCEMS) to the CPCB server.
- 5) The unit shall submit evidences of a valid consent under Water Act and authorization under HW management Rules from UPPCB.
- 6) The unit shall obtain permission from Central Ground Water Board for extraction of ground water.
- 7) After completion of the above said measures, the unit shall report to CPCB and seek permission from CPCB before resumption of any manufacturing operation.

WHEREAS, the unit replies vide letters dated 7th February, 2018, 11 January, 2018, 29th December, 2017 and 11th July, 2017 were examined and following observations are made:

- 1) The unit has installed OCEMS and connected it with CPCB server.
- 2) The unit has submitted the details of the modifications done in its ETP along with the ETP size.
- 3) The unit has also submitted undertaking to ensure compliance with stipulated standards.

WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-Member Committee vide office order dated 27th September, 2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF & CC & NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 27th February, 2018 examined the replies dated 7th February, 2018, 11 January, 2018, 29th December, 2017 and 11th July, 2017 and recommended that:

- 1) The performance audit of the ETP by a government institution may be submitted and be placed before the committee.

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- 2) One month daily analysis report of treated effluent be submitted.

AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit, M/s Rama Tex Process House Pvt. Ltd., 93/2, Rithani, Delhi Road, Meerut is hereby issued directions as follows:

- 1) The unit may resume operation and shall submit performance audit report of ETP by government institution within 45 days of resumption of operation.
- 2) The unit shall submit one month daily analysis report of treated effluent from Environmental laboratory recognised under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 within 45 days of resumption of operation.
- 3) The unit shall inform to CPCB about the date of resumption of manufacturing operations.

In case of non-compliance of the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate action against the unit without giving any further notice in accordance with the provision of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
