Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986

WHEREAS, the Textile dyeing and bleaching industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the general discharge standards of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under;

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Standard Niwar Mills, D-24, Site 1, Panki, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh (here in after referred as 'the unit') is a textile unit; and

WHEREAS, inspection of the unit was conducted on 17th April, 2017 to check the status of compliance of prescribed norms; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure directions dated 2nd June, 2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 for compliance of the following directions:

- 1) The unit shall not resume its operation without installation of OCEMS with connectivity to CPCB server and shall also ensure compliance of effluent standards as notified vide notification no. GSR 978 (E) dated 10th October, 2016.
- 2) The unit shall also obtain valid consent from UPPCB before starting the operation.

WHEREAS, the unit was re-inspected on 27th June, 2017 to verify the compliance of closure directions and was found non-operational; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure directions dated 4th October, 2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 for compliance of the following directions:

- 1) The unit, M/s Standard Niwar Mills, D-24, Site 1, Panki, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh, shall remain closed and not to resume manufacture operation till compliance with the directions dated 2nd June, 2017.
- 2) The unit shall install OCEMS and will register for connectivity to CPCB portal.
- 3) The unit shall submit valid consent under Air Act and Water Act from UPPCB.

WHEREAS, the unit replies vide letter dated 23rd August, 2017, 14th September, 2017 and 14th December, 2017 were examined and following observations are made:

- 1) The unit installed online flowmeter at the final outlet of ETP.
- 2) The unit has installed electromagnetic flowmeter at the raw water intake point and is maintaining the log books for the same.
- 3) The unit has already applied for fresh air and water consent and for renewal of hazardous waste authorization.
- 4) The unit is maintaining logbooks pertaining to raw water intake, final outlet of ETP and details of chemical dosing and energy consumption for ETP.
- 5) The unit has modified its ETP and has provided undertaking to comply with stipulated standards.

AND WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-Member Committee vide office order dated 27/09/2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF& CC & NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 21st February, 2018 examined the replies dated 23rd August, 2017, 14th September, 2017 and 14th December, 2017 and recommended that:

1. The unit may resume operation only after obtaining valid consent from UPPCB;
2. Treated effluent analysis report to be provided within 45 days of resuming operation;
3. Compliance verification of the unit may be carried out by the State Pollution Control Board within 60 days.

AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit, M/s Standard Niwar Mills, D-24, Site 1, Panki, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh, is hereby directed to comply with the following directions:

1. The unit, M/s Standard Niwar Mills, D-24, Site 1, Panki, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh, shall resume operation only after obtaining valid consent from UPPCB and shall inform to CPCB about date of resumption of operation immediately.
2. The unit shall submit a treated effluent analysis report from Environmental laboratory recognized by Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, to CPCB within 45 days of resuming operation.

In case of non-compliance of the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate action against the unit without giving any further notice in accordance with the provision of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
