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**DIRECTIONS UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT,
1986**

WHEREAS, Textile dyeing and bleaching industries have been identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly on land and into water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on land and the ambient water quality and;

WHEREAS, there is need to inculcate habit of self-monitoring mechanism within the industries for complying with the prescribed standards and this can be achieved by the methods like installing online effluent & emission monitoring devices ; and

WHEREAS, for strengthening the monitoring and compliance through self-regulatory mechanism, online source emission & effluent monitoring systems need to be installed and operated by the industries on 'polluter pays principle'; and

WHEREAS, M/s. Shiva Industries, C-26, Panki Industrial Estate, Site- 1, Kanpur, UP (hereafter referred as 'the Unit') is a Textile, dyeing Industry; and

WHEREAS, the unit was inspected by a team designated by CPCB on April 07, 2017 & April 13, 2017 and the unit was found closed and the unit representative informed that the unit is closed since last 8 months and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure direction dated 13.06.2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit; and

WHEREAS, the unit has reply vide letter dated 10.01.2018 was examined and following observations made:

1. The unit has submitted a copy of consent to operate under Air and Water Act issued by UPPCB with validity upto 31.12.2018.
2. The Unit has installed OCEMS system for treated effluent monitoring and provided connectivity with CPCB server.

AND WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a three-member committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF & CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the three member committee in its meeting held on 21.02.2018 examined the reply of the Unit and recommended that (i) the Unit may be allowed to resume operation after obtaining valid consent to operate (ii) the unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report from laboratory recognized under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 within 45 days of resumption of operations; and (iii) compliance verification by UPPCB within 60 days of resumption of the unit's manufacturing operations; and

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above mentioned observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman CPCB, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit is directed to comply with the following directions:

1. The unit may resume operation and shall treat their effluent to meet the effluent discharge standards as notified under Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986.
2. The unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report from laboratory recognized under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 within 45 days of resumption of operations
3. The unit **M/s. Shiva Industries, C-26, Panki Industrial Estate, Site- 1, Kanpur, UP** shall ensure continuous connectivity with CPCB server.
4. The Unit shall immediately inform to CPCB regarding the resumption of operations.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate action without any further notice, in accordance with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
