Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986

WHEREAS, the Textile dyeing and bleaching industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the general discharge standards of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under;

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Pilakhua Waterproofing Co. Pvt. Ltd., Jindal Nagar, Hapur (here in after referred as 'the unit') is involved in the process of conversion of canvass cloth after dyeing into waterproof cloth; and

WHEREAS, inspection of the unit was conducted to check the status of compliance of prescribed norms; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure directions dated 21<sup>st</sup> June, 2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 for compliance of the following directions:

- 1) The unit shall stop all manufacturing operations immediately until all the necessary pollution control measures are planned and implemented so as to comply with OCEMS in the unit and the ETP effluent discharge as per the prescribed norms.
- 2) The unit shall report to CPCB about stopping of manufacturing operations immediately.
- 3) The unit shall seek permission from CPCB before resumption of manufacturing operation.

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WHEREAS, the unit replies vide letters dated 11<sup>th</sup> July,2017, 23<sup>rd</sup> July,2017, 8<sup>th</sup> August,2017, 7<sup>th</sup> September,2017, 1<sup>st</sup> December,2017 and 27<sup>th</sup> December,2017 were examined and following observations are made:

1. The unit has valid consent upto 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2018. However, the unit has applied to UPPCB for reduction of discharge from 11.5 KLD to 4.5 KLD.
2. The unit has connected its webcam and flowmeter with CPCB server.
3. The unit has also submitted self certificate and undertaking for compliance of CPCB directions.
4. The unit has also submitted adequacy report for its ETP.

WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-Member Committee vide office order dated 27/09/2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF& CC & NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 21<sup>st</sup> February,2018 examined the replies dated 11<sup>th</sup> July,2017, 23<sup>rd</sup> July,2017, 8<sup>th</sup> August,2017, 7<sup>th</sup> September,2017, 1<sup>st</sup> December,2017 and 27<sup>th</sup> December,2017 and recommended that:

- 1) Conditional revoke of the closure directions may be issued for obtaining valid consent with reduced capacity of 4.5 KLD;
- 2) Treated effluent analysis report to be provided within 45 days of resuming operation;
- 3) Compliance verification of the unit to be carried out by the State Pollution Control Board within 60 days of resumption of operation.

AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit, M/s Pilakhua Waterproofing Co. Pvt. Ltd., Jindal Nagar, Hapur is hereby directed to comply with the following directions:

- 1) The unit shall resume operation only after obtaining valid consent with reduced capacity from UPPCB and shall inform to CPCB about date of resumption of operation immediately.
- 2) The unit shall submit a treated effluent analysis report from Environmental laboratory recognized by Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, to CPCB within 45 days of resuming operation.

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In case of non-compliance of the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate action against the unit without giving any further notice in accordance with the provision of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
