Sub.: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 regarding installation of on-line effluent and emission monitoring system.

WHEREAS, the Pharmaceutical industries are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, M/s. Vani Pharma Labs Ltd., (Unit- II), Telangana (herein after referred to as the Unit) which comes under pharmaceutical category, has installed online flow meter and web camera as the Online continuous effluent Monitoring system (OCEMS) as it is sending effluent to common effluent treatment plant (CETP); and

WHEREAS, it was observed by the IT division of the CPCB that the Online continuous effluent Monitoring system (OCEMS) of the Unit was in offline mode during the month of 15 September-15 October 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Unit was inspected by a team of official(s) from the CPCB Regional Directorate, Bengaluru on November 30, 2017 to assess the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures and online effluent monitoring system, in view of observations of the inspecting team a show cause notice was issued to the Unit vide letter dated December 22, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Unit submitted the compliance information through email dated January 15, 2018 to the CPCB and requested to revoke the Show Cause Notice; and

WHEREAS, a letter dated January 15, 2018 was sent to the Regional Directorate, Bengaluru to re-inspect the Unit and verify the compliance status of the of the Unit; and

WHEREAS, the Unit was inspected by a team of official(s) from the CPCB Regional Directorate, Bengaluru on January 30, 2018 to verify the compliance status of the of the Unit w.r.t. Show Cause Notice dated December 22, 2017 issued to the Unit and main observations of the inspecting team are as following:



- 1) The unit has still not provided the dedicated area to the storage of Hazardous Waste.
- 2) The unit has stored the wastes in open area, about 4 tons of organic residue was stored beneath the ETP however as per HW authorization the unit has not store Hazardous waste more than 90 days.

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the following directions are being issued:


1. The Unit shall provide dedicated storage area for Hazardous waste by April 15, 2018 and the waste shall be stored only in the dedicated storage area in a separate shed.
2. The Unit shall dispose all the Hazardous waste & organic waste stored in the Unit premises by April 15, 2018 to TSDF.

The Unit M/s. Vani Pharma Labs Ltd., (Unit- II), Telangana shall submit the compliance report for the direction at above points with photographic evidence within 30 days time after receipt of direction. Failure to comply with the above directions will attract action in accordance with the provision of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
