**Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986**

WHEREAS, the Textile, dyeing and bleaching industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the general discharge standards of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under;

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Shiva Knitwear, B-15, 16, Site-4, Panki Industrial area, Kanpur (here in after referred as 'the unit') is a textile processing unit;

WHEREAS, inspection of the unit was conducted on 7<sup>th</sup> April, 2017 and 10<sup>th</sup> May, 2017 to check the status of compliance of prescribed norms; and

WHEREAS, the unit was issued closure directions dated 15<sup>th</sup> May, 2017 for non-installation of OCEMS; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure directions dated 27<sup>th</sup> June, 2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 for compliance of the following directions:

- 1) The unit, M/s Shiva Knitwear, B-15, 16, Site-4, Panki Industrial area, Kanpur shall close down all the manufacturing operations with immediate effect till Effluent Treatment Plant is properly functional so as to meet the discharge standards as per the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

- 2) The unit shall report to CPCB regarding closure of manufacturing operations in compliance of directions.
- 3) The unit shall install water flow meter at bore well and maintain a log book on daily basis.
- 4) The unit will ensure to close all the outlets other than the ETP; no effluent is discharged without treatment.
- 5) The unit shall install the online effluent monitoring system before resuming operations and ensure the connectivity with CPCB server.
- 6) After compliance of the above said directions, the unit shall report to CPCB and seek permission from CPCB before resumption of their manufacturing operations.

**AND WHEREAS**, the unit was re-inspected on 20<sup>th</sup> June, 2017 to verify the compliance status and was found operational at the time of inspection, in violation of closure directions dated 15<sup>th</sup> May, 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, CPCB issued closure directions dated 6<sup>th</sup> November, 2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 for compliance of the following directions:

- 1) The unit shall remain closed and not operate/ start manufacturing without permission of CPCB.
- 2) The unit shall ensure proper operation and maintenance of its ETP.
- 3) The unit shall comply with CPCB directions dated 15<sup>th</sup> May, 2017 and 27<sup>th</sup> June, 2017 issued under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
- 4) The unit shall seek permission from CPCB before resumption of operation.

**WHEREAS**, the unit replies vide letters dated 27<sup>th</sup> July, 2017, 8<sup>th</sup> September, 2017, 21<sup>st</sup> November, 2017, 4<sup>th</sup> December, 2017 and 9<sup>th</sup> December, 2017 were examined and following observations are made:

- 1) The unit has provided online connectivity of flow meter with CPCB server.
- 2) The unit has applied for air and water consent with reduced discharge capacity of 8 KLD and 0.5 KLD for domestic discharge.
- 3) The unit has provided plan of modified ETP as well as photographs.
- 4) The unit has applied for NOC for groundwater abstraction to CGWA and applied for hazardous waste authorization to UPPCB.

**WHEREAS**, CPCB constituted a Three-Member Committee vide office order dated 27<sup>th</sup> September, 2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF & CC & NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 27<sup>th</sup> February, 2018 examined the replies dated 27<sup>th</sup> July, 2017, 8<sup>th</sup> September, 2017, 21<sup>st</sup> November, 2017, 4<sup>th</sup> December, 2017 and 9<sup>th</sup> December, 2017 and recommended that:

- 1) The unit is recommended for resuming the operation for one month only to assess the performance of ETP inspection by CPCB/authorized agency. The final assessment report shall be placed before the committee.

AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit, **M/s Shiva Knitwear, B-15, 16, Site-4, Panki Industrial area, Kanpur** is hereby issued direction as follows:

- 1) The unit shall resume its operation for one month only to assess the performance of ETP inspection by CPCB/ authorized agency. The unit shall inform the date of resumption of operation to CPCB and shall close down operation after inspection of the unit.

In case of non-compliance of the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate action against the unit without giving any further notice in accordance with the provision of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
