Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 – reg.

WHEREAS, Fertilizer units are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, a direction under section 18 (1) (b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 was issued on February 05, 2014 to all the State Pollution Control Boards (SPCBs)/ Pollution Control Committees (PCCs) for installation of online emission monitoring system w.r.t. Urea Plants – PM, CAN/NPK/Ammonium Nitrite – PM, Ammonia, Fluoride, DAP plants – PM, Fluoride & SSP plants – PM, Fluoride parameters & online effluent monitoring system w.r.t. pH, Ammonical Nitrogen, Fluoride & Flow parameters in Fertilizer industries; and

WHEREAS, it was clarified that flow meter & web camera may be installed in case of Units with zero liquid discharge (ZLD) by March 31, 2015 vide guidelines uploaded on website of CPCB dated November 7, 2014; and

WHEREAS, a Show Cause Notice under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act 1986, was issued by Central pollution control board on July 24, 2015 to the **M/s Shiva Global Agro Industries Ltd. (formerly M/s Shiva Fertilizers Ltd), Village Dhakni, Dist. Nanded, Maharashtra** to show cause as to why the Unit should not be closed down if, the Unit has not complied fully with the directions issued w.r.t. installation of online emission & effluent monitoring system by June 30, 2015. Further it was directed to submit documentary evidence regarding status of installation and connectivity; and

WHEREAS, the unit was inspected on November 10, 2017 by officials of CPCB, RD, Vadodara w.r.t. offline status of online continuous effluent and emission monitoring system (OCEMS) of the unit since 16.09.2017 and observed that the OCEMS of the unit is under maintenance due to technical problems and the plant is under shut down.

WHEREAS the unit vide letter dated 18.12.2017 informed CPCB that it has started production activities at its plant.

WHEREAS, as per the verification report dated January 25, 2018 generated by the IT division, CPCB; the Unit has provided the connectivity of the online emission monitoring system to the CPCB but has not provided the connectivity of the online effluent monitoring system to CPCB; and

WHEREAS, on the basis of above stated observations directions under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act 1986, were issued by Central Pollution Control Board on February 05, 2018 to **M/s Shiva Global Agro Industries Ltd. (formerly M/s Shiva Fertilizers Ltd), Village Dhakni, Dist. Nanded, Maharashtra** to close down all operational activities with immediate effect; and

WHEREAS, the unit vide email dated February 22, 2018 submitted the login details for connectivity of online continuous emission and effluent monitoring system; and

WHEREAS, the connectivity of continuous online data for emission and effluent monitoring submitted by the unit was verified as per IT division, CPCB report dated February 28, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Unit has informed vide Self certificate dated February 28, 2018 that the unit has stopped production since February 10, 2018; and


WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-member committee vide office order dated 03.10.2017 having representative(s) from CPCB and MoEF&CC for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the Three-member committee in its meeting held on 16.03.2018 examined the compliance report submitted by the Unit and recommended that the Unit may be allowed to resume operations.

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of powers vested to chairman CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and in view of undertaking submitted by unit under reference, the directions issued under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the **M/s Shiva Global Agro Industries Ltd. (formerly M/s Shiva Fertilizers Ltd), Village Dhakni, Dist. Nanded, Maharashtra** vide letter dated February 05, 2018 is hereby revoked.


