Sub: Direction under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

WHEREAS, the cement plants are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed thereunder; and

WHEREAS, there is need to inculcate habit of self-monitoring within the industries for complying with the prescribed standards and this can be achieved by the methods like installing online emission monitoring devices; and

WHEREAS, for strengthening the monitoring and compliance through self-regulatory mechanism, online source emission and effluent monitoring systems need to be installed and operated by the industries on 'polluter pays principle'; and

WHEREAS, a direction under section 18 (1) (b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 was issued on February 05, 2014 to all the State Pollution Control Boards (SPCBs)/ Pollution Control Committees (PCCs) for installation of online emission monitoring system for PM, NO_x and SO₂ in cement industries; and

WHEREAS, considering the requests/ representations received from industries/ industrial associations/ SPCBs / PCCs, an extension of time up to June 30, 2015 for installation of online monitoring systems was granted vide direction dated March 02, 2015 under section 18 (1) (b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981; and

WHEREAS, a letter dated May 29, 2015 was issued by the Chairman, CPCB to all the SPCBs/ PCCs informing that no further extension of time will be given after June 30, 2015 and consent to operate will be withdrawn alongwith forfeiture of bank guarantee of non-complying units; and

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WHEREAS, concerned SPCB/ PCC issued directions under section 33A of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and section 31A of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, to install the online monitoring system by June 30, 2015 and to submit bank guarantee of 100% of the cost of online emission & effluent monitoring system; and

WHEREAS, as per revised action plan submitted for implementation of revised norms vide letter dated, 13.10.2017, it was committed that the unit will comply the revised emission norms by August 31, 2018; and


WHEREAS, CPCB RD-Bhopal inspected M/s Ultratech Cement Ltd. (Formerly M/s J. P. Bela Cement Works), Bela Cement Works, MP was during 06-07/02/2018 to investigate high SMS alerts/Offline status and the inspecting team made following observations:

1. **The unit had consent under Water and Air Act valid upto 30.09.2017 and thus unit needs to obtain a valid consent from SPCB.**
2. **The unit should improve housekeeping in plant, especially at all internal roads near coal handling area, clinker area and cement mill.**
3. **OCEMS data of all stacks are not being transmitted to CPCB server regularly. Data of some stacks are not being transmitted since November 2015 and January 2017 (IT division report enclosed). Also, the unit is not receiving SMS alerts since July 2017. Therefore, the unit needs to resolve the issue of data transmission with CPCB at the earliest.**
4. **The unit should store limestone in covered shed.**
5. **The unit should develop more green belt in and around the plant premises and mining area.**

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Government of India, vide Notification No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof;


Now, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations/recommendations and exercising the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, M/s Ultratech Cement Ltd. (Formerly M/s J. P. Bela Cement Works), Bela Cement Works, MP is hereby directed to comply w.r.t. the point 1-3 above within one month and submit action plan for 4 & 5.

The industry shall submit reply and action taken report/action plan within 15 days from the date of issue of this direction. In case of failure, the Board will be constrained to initiate action as deemed necessary and appropriate under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.


