Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 regarding installation of on-line effluent and emission monitoring system-Show Cause Notice.

WHEREAS, the Pharmaceutical industries are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, M/s. S. S. Organics Limited, Telangana (herein after referred to as the Unit) has installed online monitoring system voluntarily, no CPCB direction has been issued to the Unit; and

WHEREAS, the Online effluent Monitoring system of the Unit was in offline mode during the month of April-May 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Unit was inspected by a team of official(s) from the CPCB Regional Directorate, Bangalore on July 27, 2017 to assess the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures and online effluent monitoring system; and

WHEREAS, a closure direction has been issued to the Unit vide letter dated September 05, 2017 on the basis of observations of the inspecting team; and

WHEREAS, the closure direction has been revoked on December 19, 2017 with a condition that the unit shall be re-inspected within 45 days of resumption of its operation after compliance status of the closure direction submitted by the Unit; and

WHEREAS, the Unit was inspected by the officials of RD, Bengaluru on February 02, 2018 to verify the compliance of the direction and observed the following:

- 1) At the time of inspection ATFD was not in operation and MEE concentrate was stored in a tank. The effluent stored in collection tanks shows that the ETP was not operated regularly.
- 2) The used and filled drums are scattered haphazardly in the unit premises.
- 3) The housekeeping of the Unit is not good, still lot more measures need to be taken.
- 4) The unit has not provided the proper space for the storage of hazardous waste.

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, a notice is hereby served to the unit (M/s. S. S. Organics Limited, Telangana) to show cause why the Unit should not be closed down as the Unit is not complying with respect to the above mentioned observations of the inspecting team.

The compliance of above direction (notice) with photographic evidence shall be submitted to this office within 30 days of the receipt of the directions. In case of failure to comply with the said directions necessary action as deemed fit under the provision of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 will be taken by CPCB.
