Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986

WHEREAS, the Textile dyeing and bleaching industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the general discharge standards of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under;

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Garima Industries, 1533, Magarwara, Unnao (U.P.) (here in after referred as 'the unit') is a textile processing unit and is engaged in the dyeing process of tarpaulin/cotton canvas; and

WHEREAS, inspection of the unit was conducted on 24th March, 2017 to check the status of compliance of prescribed norms; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure directions dated 1st May, 2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 for compliance of the following directions:

- 1) The unit, M/s Garima Industries, 1533, Magarwara, District Unnao, Uttar Pradesh, shall close down all the manufacturing operations with immediate effect.
- 2) The unit shall report to CPCB regarding closure of manufacturing operation and compliance of directions.

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- 3) The unit shall install OCEMS (Online Continuous Effluent Monitoring System) at its ETP for the prescribed parameters namely pH, BOD, COD, TSS and Flow and, shall provide 24x7 data transmission facilities to CPCB and UPPCB.
- 4) The unit shall immediately dismantle its effluent bypass system and inform about the same to CPCB.
- 5) The unit shall obtain Consent Orders from Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board (UPPCB) under Air Act 1981, Water Act 1974 and for Hazardous Waste Authorization.
- 6) The unit shall install water flow meter to the borewell.
- 7) The unit shall maintain proper logbooks for all the relevant activities.
- 8) The unit shall take adequate measures to implement the charter norms.
- 9) The unit shall obtain permission from CPCB before resumption of any manufacturing operations.

WHEREAS, the unit replies vide letters dated 22nd November, 2017 and 29th December, 2017 were examined and following observations are made:

- 1) The unit has provided connectivity with CPCB server.
- 2) The unit has air and water consent valid till 31st December, 2018.
- 3) The unit has also submitted self certificate and undertaking for compliance of CPCB directions.
- 4) The unit has also submitted the details of modifications done in the ETP.

WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-Member Committee vide office order dated 27th September, 2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF & CC & NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 27th February, 2018 examined the replies dated 22nd November, 2017 and 29th December, 2017 and recommended that:

- 1) The unit is recommended for revocation for one month to stabilize the ETP during which the unit shall be inspected by CPCB.

AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit, M/s Garima Industries, 1533, Magarwara, Unnao (U.P.) is hereby issued directions as follows:

- 1) The unit shall resume operation for a period of one month to stabilize its ETP.
- 2) The unit shall inform to CPCB regarding the date of resumption of operation.

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M/s Garima Industries, 1533, Magarwara, Unnao (U.P.)

In case of non-compliance of the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate action against the unit without giving any further notice in accordance with the provision of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
