Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 –reg. Revoke

WHEREAS, the Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, there is need to inculcate habit of self-monitoring within the industries for complying with the prescribed standards and this can be achieved by the methods like installing online effluent & emission monitoring devices; and

WHEREAS, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install effluent treatment plants (ETPs) to comply with the effluent discharge standards as notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the Rules framed there under and also to meet the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Board (SPCBs) / Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Rizwan Tanning Industries, 104/90 A (22), Sanjay Nagar, Jajmau, Kanpur UP (hereafter referred to as the 'Unit') is a Tannery industry and was inspected by CPCB officials on 25.05.2017 for verification of compliance and following observations were made:

- (i) During the inspection, the unit and PETP were found operational.
- (ii) The unit is having online flow measurement (electromagnetic flow meter) and the system has connectivity with CPCB server.
- (iii) The unit has submitted application for seeking permission of CGWA for ground water withdrawal.
- (iv) The unit is required to properly segregate chrome bearing effluent and suitably upgrade/optimize its PETP so as to ensure treated effluent confirms to prescribed standards.
- (v) The unit shall restrict wastewater discharge as prescribed in consent.
- (vi) The analysis report of treated effluent sample shows that Total Chromium Cr (T) value of 2.2 mg/l exceeds the limit as against the norm of 2.0 mg/L, which indicates non-compliance with the prescribed effluent discharge norms under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

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WHEREAS, CBCB issued Show Cause Notice dated 21.08.2017, under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, to the unit;

AND WHEREAS, the Unit replies vide letters dated 07.09.2017 and 13.03.2018 were examined and the following observation is made:

- (i) The unit has provided PETP Treated effluent analysis report carried out by CSIR-Indian Institute of Toxicology Research which shows the effluent having Total Chromium of 1.896 mg/L (as against 2.0 mg/L).

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act 1986, the Show Cause Notice dated 21.08.2017 is revoked and the unit M/s Rizwan Tanning Industries, 104/90 A (22), Sanjay Nagar, Jajmau, Kanpur UP is hereby directed to comply with the following directions:

- (i) The unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report from laboratory recognised under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 within 30 days.
- (ii) The unit shall take necessary action to ensure that primary treated effluent discharged by the unit will always comply the PETP standards prescribed by UPPCB / inlet to CETP standards and ensure that PETP effluent is treated into the CETP.
- (iii) The unit shall bring the Total Chromium within prescribed norms (2.0 mg/L) for treated effluent of PETP.

In case of failure of the unit to comply with the directions, action will be taken in accordance with the provisions under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
