Sub.: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 regarding installation of on-line effluent and emission monitoring system-Show cause Notice

WHEREAS, the Pharmaceutical industries are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, M/s. Wardex Pharmaceutical Pvt. Ltd., Uttar Pradesh (herein after referred to as the Unit) which comes under pharmaceutical category, has installed Online continuous effluent Monitoring system (OCEMS) for parameters pH, BOD, COD, TSS & Flow; and

WHEREAS, total 846 sms alert received for parameters pH & BOD for the Unit during the month of 15 January- 15 February 2018 for not meeting the prescribed limits; and

WHEREAS, the Unit was inspected by a team of official(s) from the CPCB Regional Directorate, Lucknow on March 19, 2018 to assess the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures and online effluent monitoring system, observed as following:

- The Unit has manufacturing the product, the name of which is not mentioned the consent issued from the Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board.
- The Unit has discharging more waste water than the consented limit.
- The Unit has to obtain the permission from the CGWA for the extraction of ground water as mentioned in the consent.
- The pH electrode and COD probe attached in the Online Continuous Effluent Monitoring System (OCEMS) is not working properly.
- The Unit has to remove the filtration unit fixed before the OCEMS.

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, a notice is hereby served to the Unit (M/s. Wardex Pharmaceutical Pvt. Ltd., Uttar Pradesh) to show cause why the Unit should not be closed down as the Unit is not complying with respect to the above mentioned observations of the inspecting team.

The compliance of above direction (notice) shall be submitted to this office within 30 days of the receipt of the directions. In case of failure to comply with the said directions necessary action as deemed fit under the provision of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 will be taken by CPCB.


