**Sub: Direction under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 - Notice thereof.**

WHEREAS, Dye & Dye Intermediate units are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, Central Pollution Control Board, Regional Directorate, Bhopal inspected M/s Trent Chemical Industries, Plot No. 184, AKVN Industrial Area, Jhabua, Meghnagar, Madhya Pradesh- 457779 (hereinafter called as the unit) on April 11, 2018 to assess the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures and made the following observations:

1. The catch pit meant for collection of storm water, located near iron sludge storage area was observed to have minor cracks that may cause percolation of effluent to ground water.
2. The analysis results of ground water samples collected from three piezometers have shown contamination with COD, Iron and Lead. The COD in the three ground water samples has been reported as 130.5 mg/l, 264.9 mg/l and 39.9 mg/l respectively, indicating contamination with industrial effluent. The concentration of Iron has been reported as 2.963 mg/l, 2.410 mg/l and 0.387 mg/l respectively against permissible limits 0.3 mg /l as per IS 10500 standard prescribed by Bureau of Indian Standards. Similarly, lead has been reported as 0.131 mg/l, 0.266 mg/l and 0.094 mg/l against permissible limit of 0.01 mg /l.
3. The spray drier and boiler areas were observed to be heavily occupied by the hazardous waste. It was informed that the TSDF has not lifted the hazardous waste from the last three months which resulted in huge quantity of accumulated waste. The finished product DASDA was also observed to be stored in open.

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

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
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**NOW, THEREFORE,** under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, notice is hereby issued to **M/s Trent Chemical Industries, Plot No. 184, AKVN Industrial Area, Jhabua, Meghnagar, Madhya Pradesh- 457779** to show cause why your unit shall not be directed to close down all operational activities with immediate effect until following directions are complied :


1. The unit shall take necessary steps to prevent any seepage of effluent to the ground.
2. The unit shall get the ground water monitoring done by a reputed Government institution within 5 Km radius of the unit covering both upstream and downstream locations to assess the level of ground water contamination caused by the unit.
3. The unit shall submit the time bound remediation plan for restoration of quality of contaminated ground water back to within permissible limits.
4. The unit shall immediately dispose the accumulated hazardous waste and shall not store the hazardous and other wastes for a period exceeding ninety days.
5. The unit shall take adequate steps for proper storage of hazardous waste as per Hazardous & other Waste (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.
6. The unit shall ensure the storage of any raw material or finished product in scientific manner in a closed area.

The time bound action plan for compliance of above directions shall be submitted to Central Pollution Control Board within 30 days of the receipt of the directions. In case of failure to comply with the said directions necessary action as deemed fit under the provision of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 will be taken by Central Pollution Control Board.
