Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986

WHEREAS, the Textile dyeing and bleaching industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the general discharge standards of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under;

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Rupkishan Ajay Kumar, Dyeing & Printing Works, Angooribagh, Farrukhabad -U.P. (here in after referred as 'the unit') is a textile unit; and

WHEREAS, inspection of the unit was conducted on 29th March, 2017 to check the status of compliance of prescribed norms; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure directions dated 15th May, 2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 for compliance of the following directions:

- 1) The unit shall stop all wet process operations immediately till installation and commissioning of online continuous effluent monitoring system (OCEMS) and provide connectivity to the CPCB server for continuous 24 X7 data transmission.
- 2) The unit shall report to CPCB about stopping of wet process operations immediately.
- 3) The unit shall seek permission from CPCB before resumption of wet process operation.

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WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure directions dated 28th June, 2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 for compliance of the following directions:

1. The unit shall remain closed till it has adequate arrangements for treating effluent, installs & connects online effluent monitoring system and possesses valid consent.
2. The Unit shall seek permission from CPCB before resumption of manufacturing operation.

WHEREAS, the unit replies vide letters dated 20th June, 2017 and 22nd February, 2018 were examined and following observations are made:

- 1) The unit has installed OCEMS and connected it with CPCB server.
- 2) The unit has submitted adequacy report of its ETP along with the relevant documents.

WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-Member Committee vide office order dated 27th September, 2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF & CC & NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 27th April, 2018 examined the replies dated 20th June, 2017 and 22nd February, 2018 and recommended the unit to resume operation;

AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit, **M/s Rupkishan Ajay Kumar, Dyeing & Printing Works, Angooribagh, Farrukhabad -U.P.** is hereby issued directions as follows:

- 1) The unit shall remain closed and shall resume operation after obtaining valid consent from UPPCB. The unit shall inform to CPCB about date of resumption of operation immediately.
- 2) The unit shall ensure regular connectivity of its OCEMS with CPCB server and shall comply with stipulated standards of CPCB.
- 3) The unit shall submit copy of valid consent to CPCB
- 4) The unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report from a laboratory recognized under E (P) Act, 1986 to CPCB within 30 days of resumption of manufacturing operation.

In case of non-compliance of the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate action against the unit without giving any further notice in accordance with the provision of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
