Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986- reg.

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under; and

WHEREAS, Textile dyeing and bleaching industries have been identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the air and water quality and;

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications no. S.O. 157(E) of 27.02.1996 has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the emission and effluent standards notified under the environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and other standards and norms; and

WHEREAS, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install effluent treatment plants (ETPs) to comply with the effluent discharged standards as notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under and also to meet the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Board (SPCBs) / Pollution Control Committee (PCCs); and

WHEREAS, M/s. Hanung Toys and Textiles, Lakeshwari Ind. Area, Lakeshwari, Baghwanpur, Roorkee, Distt. Haridwar, Uttarakhand (hereafter referred to as the Unit) is a textile processing unit; and

WHEREAS, CPCB has issued show cause notice dated 21.06.2016 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to install Online Continuous Effluent Monitoring System (OCEMS); and

WHEREAS, a team deputed by CPCB inspected the unit on 25.03.2017 for carrying out inspection of the unit and the team was not allowed to enter into the premises of the unit to collect the effluent samples and carry out inspection of the unit; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure direction dated 06.06.2017 under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit; and

WHEREAS, the unit reply vide letter dated 27.06.2017, 14.11.2017, 01.11.2017, 05.08.2017, 20.12.2017 and 02.02.2018 are examined and following observations are made:

1. The unit is maintaining the zero liquid discharge since 2008 as per the direction /guidelines issued to textile, dyeing and bleaching industries.
2. The unit has installed flow meter and web camera at ETP outlet and provided connectivity to CPCB server.

3. The team which was visited unit on 25.03.2017, only showed the ID card of Pollution Control Research Institute, BHEL and did not produced any documentary evidence to prove that it has been deputed by CPCB to collect the effluent and carryout inspection.
4. The unit is ready and willing to get it inspected as per CPCB guidelines/directions.
5. The unit has submitted adequacy assessment of existing ETP report.

AND WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a three-member committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF & CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the three-member committee in its meeting held on 22.11.2017 examined the replies of the Unit and asked for following measures:

1. The unit shall submit adequacy report for ZLD by reputed institution.
2. The unit shall provide method for disposal of RO reject.
3. The unit shall take measures ETP from aging and produce evidence.
4. The unit shall submit ETP photographs with dimension of the units. of ETP.
5. The unit shall install flow meter at recycling point.

AND WHEREAS, the unit reply vide letter dated 05.08.2017, 20.12.2017 and 02.02.2018 were examined and following observations are made:

1. The unit has submitted adequacy report for ZLD by CPPRI.
2. The unit has submitted ETP photographs with dimension of the units of ETP.
3. The unit installed flow meter at recycling point

AND WHEREAS, the three-member committee in its meeting held on 27.04.2018 examined replies of the Unit and recommended that the Unit may be allowed to resume operation. The unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report from laboratory recognized under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 within 30 days of resumption of operations; and

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit **M/s. Hanung Toys and Textiles, Lakeshwari Ind. Area, Lakeshwari Baghwanpur, Roorkee, Distt. Haridwar, Uttarakhand** is directed to comply with the following directions:

1. The Unit shall remain closed and may resume manufacturing operations after seeking valid consent to operate from Uttarakhand Environment Protection Pollution Control Board.
2. The Unit shall immediately inform to CPCB regarding the resumption of operations.
3. The Unit shall operate ETP properly so as to ensure compliance with the effluent discharge norms notified under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
4. The Unit shall submit one month treated effluent analysis report from Environmental Laboratory recognized under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 within 30 days of resumption of operation.
5. The Unit shall ensure continuous connectivity OCEMS with CPCB server.
6. The Unit shall obtain permission form CGWA for extraction of groundwater.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate action against the Unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
