DIRECTIONS UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986- REG.

WHEREAS, Textile dyeing and bleaching industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the air and water quality and;

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the general discharge standards of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under; and

WHEREAS, all industries are required to install and regularly operate the requisite pollution control facilities to comply with the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants; and

WHEREAS, M/s. Kamal Dyeing House B-5, Udyog Puram, Meerut, UP (here in after referred as 'the Unit') is involved in the process of washing, bleaching, dyeing, drying, manual printing and finishing of raw cloth in to Bed Sheets; and

WHEREAS, the unit was inspected by officials deputed by CPCB on 30.03.2017 and observed the following:

1. The Unit has not installed OCEMS for treated effluent & also not registered with CPCB, Delhi for the same.
2. Unit does not meet the required standard norms for treated effluent for parameters COD (466 mg/l against prescribed norms - 250 mg/l), BOD (154 mg/l against prescribed norms -30 mg/l) & Colour (472 Units against prescribed norms 150 Units) as per sample analysis report.
3. Unit neither has approval of CGWA for bore well nor installed raw water meter.

AND WHEREAS, CPCB issued a closure direction dated 15.05.2017 and 21.06.2017 under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the Unit and directed to comply with the following directions: i) The unit shall stop all manufacturing operations immediately unit all the necessary pollution control measures are planned and implemented so as to comply with OCEMS in the unit and the ETP effluent discharge as per the prescribed norms; ii) The unit shall report to CPCB about stopping of manufacturing operations immediately and iii) The unit shall seek permission from CPCB before resumption of manufacturing operation.

WHEREAS, the unit's replies vide letters dated 01.08.2017, 02.11.2017, 29.01.2018, and 14.03.2018 were examined and following observations are made:

- a. The Unit has installed OCEMS and connected it with CPCB server.
- b. The Unit has submitted adequacy report of its ETP done by a private firm.
- c. The Unit has submitted Consents under Air and Water Acts upto 31st December 2020.

AND WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a three-member committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change and National Mission for Clean Ganga for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the three-member committee in its meeting held on 27.04.2018 examined the replies of the Unit and recommended for revoke of the closure direction issued to the Unit by CPCB under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 with the following conditions (i) *Unit is recommended for revoke for 45 days only with condition;* (ii) *Adequacy report of ETP system needs to be submitted from a reputed Government institution i.e. IIT within 45 days of resumption of operations.* (iii) *Performance audit report will be reviewed by Committee for final revocation.*

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board the closure direction at 15.05.2017 and 21.06.2017 issued to the unit are revoked and following directions are issued for compliance to **M/s. Kamal Dyeing House B-5, Udyog Puram, Meerut, UP:**

- 1) The Unit may resume manufacturing operations for 45 days only and shall immediately inform to CPCB regarding the date of resumption of operations.
- 2) The Unit will carry out performance audit of ETP system from a reputed Government institution within 45 days of resumption of operations and provide the performance audit report to CPCB.
- 3) The Unit shall operate ETP properly so as to ensure with the effluent discharge norms notified under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
- 4) The Unit shall ensure continuous connectivity of OCEMS system installed at the outlet of ETP with CPCB server.
- 5) The Unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report for within 30 days of resumption of operations from a laboratory recognized under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the Unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
