DIRECTIONS UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986- REG.

WHEREAS, Textile dyeing and bleaching industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the air and water quality and;

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the general discharge standards of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under; and

WHEREAS, all industries are required to install and regularly operate the requisite pollution control facilities to comply with the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants; and

WHEREAS, M/s. Sarvodaya Bleaching Works, G-96, Panki Industrial Area, Site-3, Kanpur, UP (hereafter referred to as the Unit) is involved in the process of bleaching and washing of fabric; and

WHEREAS, the unit was inspected on 05.04.2017 by the officials deputed by the CPCB, and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure direction dated 30.06.2017 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the Unit to comply with the following directions: i) The Unit shall stop all wet process operations immediately till installation and commissioning of online continuous effluent monitoring system (OCEMS), registration on CPCB portal and provide connectivity to the CPCB server for continuous 24*7 data transmission; ii) The unit shall report to CPCB about stopping of wet process operation immediately; iii) Unit shall install water meter at tube well (Water source); iv) Unit shall operate the ETP properly so as to comply with the treated effluent discharge norms as per Gazette notification dated 10.10.2016 under Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986; v) The unit shall provide a copy of valid consent to CPCB; vi) The unit shall seek permission from CPCB before resumption of wet process operation.

AND WHEREAS, the unit's replies vide letters dated 03.10.2017, 25.10.2017, 28.10.2017, 25.11.2017, 04.12.2017, 07.01.2018, 12.01.2018, 04.03.2018 and 18.04.2018 were examined and following observations are made:

- a. The unit has provided modified ETP details.
- b. The Unit has informed about installation of electromagnetic flow meter at tubewell.
- c. Online flow meter & web camera has installed at ETP outlet and connected with CPCB server.
- d. The Unit has submitted application to UPPCB for grant of Consent to Operate under Water and Air Acts with a discharge capacity of 5.5 KLD (5KLD industrial + 0.5 KLD domestic).
- e. The Unit has submitted application to CGWA requesting NOC to abstract ground water and provided copy of application.

AND WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a three-member committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change and National Mission for Clean Ganga for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the three-member committee in its meeting held on 27.04.2018 examined replies of the Unit and following recommendations are made (i) The Unit is recommended for revocation with discharge capacity of 5.5 KLD; (ii) Performance audit report of ETP system from a reputed Government institution within 45 days and submit to CPCB; (iii) CPCB will examine the adequacy report and take decision accordingly.

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the following directions are issued for compliance to **M/s. Sarvodaya Bleaching Works, G-96, Panki Industrial Area, Site-3, Kanpur, UP:**

- 1) The Unit will operate after obtaining valid consent to operate under Water Act and Air Act with discharge capacity as per application submitted to UPPCB.
- 2) The Unit shall immediately inform to CPCB regarding the date of resumption of operations.
- 3) The Unit will carry out performance audit of ETP system from a reputed Government institution within 45 days of resumption of operations and provide the performance audit report to CPCB.
- 4) The Unit shall operate ETP properly so as to ensure with the effluent discharge norms notified under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
- 5) The Unit shall ensure continuous connectivity of OCEMS system installed at the outlet of ETP with CPCB server.
- 6) The Unit shall submit copy of Consent to Operate to CPCB.
- 7) The Unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report for within 30 days of resumption of operations from a laboratory recognized under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the Unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
