DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of emission and effluent standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, the unit was inspected on 26.05.2017 by CPCB officials and it was observed that unit was closed since the last 15 years and structure/machinery were found in non-operational conditions; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure direction dated Oct 23rd, 2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit to remain closed; and

WHEREAS, the unit vide letter dated 10.02.2018 informed that it has changed its nature of work to testing and assembly of solar photo voltaic panel, in which no effluent will be generated (dry nature of work) and requested permission from CPCB to getting renewal of factory licence ; and

WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-member committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF & CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and


WHEREAS, the Three-member committee in its meeting held on 27.04.2018 examined and recommended that the unit may be allowed to resume operation.

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AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observation, and exercising powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit (**M/s Indian Telephone Industries, UPSIDC, Mirzapur Road, Naini, Allahabad, Uttar Pradesh**) is directed to comply with the following directions;

1. The unit shall start its operation only after obtaining valid consent from the concerned State Pollution Control Board.
2. The unit shall handle solid waste as per prevailing law.
3. The unit shall not generate any process effluent and operate only dry process.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate action against the unit in accordance with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, without giving any further notice.
