**Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986**

WHEREAS, the Textile dyeing and bleaching industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the general discharge standards of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under;

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Dilshad Textile (Dyeing unit), MohSarari, Rajbali, Nehtaur, Bijnor-U.P. (here in after referred as 'the unit') is a dyeing unit; and

WHEREAS, inspection of the unit was conducted on 18th April, 2017 to check the status of compliance of prescribed norms; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure directions dated 6<sup>th</sup> June, 2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 for compliance of the following directions:

- 1) The unit shall close down all manufacturing operations and not to start till continuous online emissions / effluent monitoring system (OCEMS) along with the connectivity to UPPCB and CPCB servers are installed.
- 2) The Unit shall obtain permission from CPCB before starting the manufacturing operations

WHEREAS, the unit replies vide letters dated 23<sup>rd</sup> June,2017, 19<sup>th</sup> July,2017, 24<sup>th</sup> July,2017, 8<sup>th</sup> September,2017, 17<sup>th</sup> March,2018 were examined and following observations are made:

- 1) The unit has installed webcamera and flowmeter and connected it with CPCB server.
- 2) The unit has submitted application for CTO given to UPPCB to reduce its wastewater discharge to 9KLD.

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WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-Member Committee vide office order dated 27<sup>th</sup> September, 2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF & CC & NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 27<sup>th</sup> April, 2018 examined the replies dated 23<sup>rd</sup> June, 2017, 19<sup>th</sup> July, 2017, 24<sup>th</sup> July, 2017, 8<sup>th</sup> September, 2017, 17<sup>th</sup> March, 2018 and recommended the unit to resume operation;

AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit, M/s Dilshad Textile (Dyeing unit), MohSarari, Rajbali, Nehtaur, Bijnor-U.P. is hereby issued directions as follows:

- 1) The unit shall remain closed and shall resume operation after obtaining valid consent with reduced capacity of effluent generation <10 KLD from UPPCB and shall inform to CPCB about date of resumption of operation immediately.
- 2) The unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report from a laboratory recognized under E (P) Act, 1986 to CPCB within 30 days of resumption of manufacturing operation.
- 3) The unit shall submit copy of valid consent to CPCB.

In case of non-compliance of the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate action against the unit without giving any further notice in accordance with the provision of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
