**Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 -reg.**

**WHEREAS**, the Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, M/s Sallan Enterprises, Near Gujraj Tanners, Sanjay Nagar, Jajmau, Kanpur, UP (hereafter referred as the Unit), is a tannery engaged in processing of semi-finished leather to produce finished leather; and

**WHEREAS**, the unit was inspected by team of officials from CPCB on 29.03.2017 and the unit was found closed. It was observed that:

- (i) The unit does not have consent to operate (CTO) from UPPCB. CTO expired on 31.12.2016.
- (ii) The unit has not provided the connectivity of online monitoring system to the CPCB.

**AND WHEREAS**, CPCB issued Closure direction dated 12.06.2017 to the unit; and

**WHEREAS**, the unit replies vide letters dated 24.07.2017, 20.09.2017, 29.11.2017, 22.12.2017, 27.02.2018 & 07.03.2018 were examined and following observation are made:

- (i) The unit has submitted copy of application for Consent to Operate under Water Act and Air Act.
- (ii) The unit has installed OCEMS and provided connectivity with CPCB server.
- (iii) The unit has submitted PETP Adequacy report prepared by NPC, Kanpur.

**AND WHEREAS**, CPCB constituted a Three-member committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF&CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

**WHEREAS**, the Three-member committee in its meeting held on 27.04.2018 examined the documents and recommended for revoke of closure direction with the following conditions:

**Contd.**

- (i) The unit may resume operation for one month and provide performance audit report of the PETP from the same institute within one month and maintain logbook properly.
- (ii) Final revocation will be considered by the committee after examination of the performance audit report of PETP.
- (iii) The unit shall start operation only after getting valid CTO from UPPCB.

**NOW THEREFORE**, in view of the above mentioned observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman CPCB, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the closure direction dated 12.06.2017 is hereby revoked and the Unit M/s Sallan Enterprises, Near Gujraj Tanners, Sanjay Nagar, Jajmau, Kanpur, UP is directed to comply with the following:

- (i) The unit shall resume operation for 30 days only and shall inform immediately to CPCB, on resumption of manufacturing operations.
- (ii) The unit shall carry out performance audit of PETP from same institute which has carried out PETP adequacy within 30 days and submit performance audit report to CPCB.
- (iii) The unit shall close its manufacturing operations after 30 days and shall seek permission from CPCB before resumption of operations.
- (iv) The unit shall start operation only after getting valid CTO from UPPCB.
- (v) The unit shall maintain log book for hazardous waste/chromium bearing sludge disposal.

In case of failure of compliance with the above directions CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
