Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 regarding installation of on-line effluent and emission monitoring system.

WHEREAS, the Pharmaceutical industries are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, M/s. SGR Chemicals Pvt. Ltd., Telangana (herein after referred to as the Unit) has installed online monitoring system voluntarily, no CPCB direction has been issued to the Unit; and

WHEREAS, the Online Effluent Monitoring system of the Unit was in offline mode during the month of 15 March-15 April, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Unit was inspected by a team of official(s) from the CPCB Regional Directorate, Bangalore on June 01, 2017 to assess the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures and online effluent monitoring system; and

WHEREAS, a closure direction has been issued to the Unit vide letter dated July 12, 2017 on the basis of observations of the inspecting team; and

WHEREAS, the closure direction has been revoked on December 19, 2017 with a condition that the unit shall be re-inspected within 45 days of resumption of its operation after compliance status of the closure direction submitted by the Unit; and

WHEREAS, the Unit was inspected by the officials of RD, Bengaluru on January 30, 2018 to verify the compliance of the direction and observed the following:

- 1) The solvent and solvent drums are scattered haphazardly in the unit premises.
- 2) The housekeeping of the Unit is not good and rusted display board has to be changed.

WHEREAS, based upon observations of inspecting team & above mentioned non-compliance a direction (show cause notice) was issued to the Unit on March 15, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Unit informed through email dated April 12, 2018 that the Unit has taken corrective action with all the points of show cause notice dated March 15, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the CPCB requested the RD, Bengaluru vide letter dated April 16, 2018 to verify the compliance of the direction submitted by the Unit against Show cause notice issued to the Unit; and

WHEREAS, the Unit was again inspected by a team of official(s) from the RD, Bangalore on April 26, 2018 to assess the compliance status of the Unit and the Unit was found complying w.r.t. show cause notice issued dated March 15, 2018 as a) the solvent and empty solvents drums were stored on cemented surface near to the process area b) General housekeeping was found improved w.r.t. cement tile flooring near to solvent/effluent storage tanks, c) the unit has provided a new display board at the entrance; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other


authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of powers vested to Chairman CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and in view of compliance with relevant direction under reference, the direction (show cause notice) issued under the Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the Unit (**M/s. SGR Chemicals Pvt. Ltd., Telangana**) vide letter dated March 15, 2018 is hereby revoked. In case of non-compliance by the Unit action as deemed fit under the provisions of Environment (P) Act, 1986 shall be taken.
