Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986

WHEREAS, the Textile dyeing and bleaching industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the general discharge standards of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under;

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Appolo Dyeing Centre, Jangi Road, Bareva Chauraha, Sohta Adda, Mirzapur-221404 (here in after referred as 'the unit') is a textile unit; and

WHEREAS, inspection of the unit was conducted on 22nd March, 2017 to check the status of compliance of prescribed norms; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure directions dated 22nd May, 2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 for compliance of the following directions:

- 1) The unit shall close all the plant operations with immediate effect and shall not resume till the following are complied.
- 2) The unit shall obtain valid consent from UPPCB.
- 3) The unit shall obtain permission from CGWA for ground water extraction.
- 4) The unit shall install flowmeters at the borewells, inlet and outlet of ETP.
- 5) The unit shall maintain logbook for the water consumption.

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- 6) The unit shall install OCEMS for online monitoring for effluent and provide connectivity to CPCB server.

AND WHEREAS, the unit replies vide letters dated 13th January, 2018, 13th February, 2018 and 19th September, 2017 were examined and following observations are made:

- 1) The unit has installed webcamera and flowmeter and connected it with CPCB server.
- 2) The unit has submitted application for obtaining valid consents to UPPCB.

AND WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-Member Committee vide office order dated 27th September, 2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF & CC & NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 18th May, 2018 examined the replies dated 13th January, 2018, 13th February, 2018 and 19th September, 2017 and recommended the unit to resume operation;

AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit, **M/s Appolo Dyeing Centre, Jangi Road, Bareva Chauraha, Sohta Adda, Mirzapur-221404** is hereby issued directions as follows:

- 1) The unit shall remain closed and shall resume operation after obtaining valid consent from UPPCB. The unit shall inform to CPCB about date of resumption of operation immediately.
- 2) The unit shall ensure regular connectivity of its OCEMS with CPCB server and shall comply with stipulated standards of CPCB.
- 3) The unit shall submit copy of valid consent to CPCB.
- 4) The unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report from Environmental lab recognized under E (P) Act, 1986 within 30 days of resumption of manufacturing operations.

In case of non-compliance of the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate action against the unit without giving any further notice in accordance with the provision of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
