Sub.: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986- Notice thereof

WHEREAS, Pesticide units are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality;

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under;

WHEREAS, Show Cause Notice under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act 1986. was issued on July 22, 2015 to all Pesticide units to show cause as to why the unit should not be closed down if, the unit has not complied fully with the directions issued w.r.t. installation of online emission & effluent monitoring system by June 30, 2015. Further it was directed to submit documentary evidence regarding status of installation and connectivity; and

WHEREAS, the unit has inspected by official of CPCB Regional Directorates, Vadodara on April 13, 2018 regarding on-line Continuous Effluent/Emission Monitoring System (OCEMS) under SMS alerts during 15 Feb- 15 March, 2018. and observed that:

- (i) The effluent sample collected at the ETP outlet w.r.t concentration of **TDS 29466 > 10000 mg/l** and **TSS 168 > 150 mg/l** are not meeting with the revised FETP inlet norms prescribed by GPCB.

WHEREAS, unit has provided connectivity w.r.t Flow and web camera as unit is sending treated Effluent to FETP for further treatment and disposal. In addition, the unit is sending data of COD parameter to CPCB server as per CPCB, IT division report dated April 24, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above and in exercise of powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 notice is hereby served to the unit to show cause that why the unit shall not be directed to close down all manufacturing / production activities until comply with the following directions:

1. The unit shall operate the ETP properly and ensure to achieve the revised FETP inlet norms as prescribed by GPCB.

The compliance of above directions shall be submitted to this office within 30 days of the receipt of this direction. In case of failure to comply with the said direction necessary action as deemed fit under the provision of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 will be taken by Central Pollution Control Board.
