**Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 – reg.**

WHEREAS, Dye & Dye Intermediate units are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, Central Pollution Control Board, Regional Directorate, Vadodara inspected M/s Micas Organics Pvt. Ltd. (Unit- II), Plot No. 3102/3101 & 3108, IV Phase, GIDC, Vapi, Gujarat on April 11, 2017 and observed that the unit is disposing the treated effluent to CETP. The treated effluent was exceeding the CETP prescribed standard limit w.r.t. TDS (8513 mg/l > 2100 mg/l); and

WHEREAS, on the basis of above stated observations, Central Pollution Control Board on April 11, 2017 issued show cause notice under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act 1986, to the unit that why the unit be not directed to close all manufacturing / production activity until it complies with the directions as specified therein; and

WHEREAS, the unit replied to the aforesaid show cause notice on April 28, 2017 and provided point wise compliance status of issued notice; and

WHEREAS, to verify the compliance status of directions of aforesaid show cause notice, Central Pollution Control Board Regional Directorate, Vadodara re inspected the unit on July 13, 2017; and

WHEREAS, during inspection on July 13, 2017 it was observed that the unit is discharging the treated effluent to CETP. The treated effluent is exceeding the CETP inlet norms w.r.t. TDS (5114 mg/l > 2100 mg/l), and Chloride (2899 mg/l > 600 mg/l); and

WHEREAS, it was observed that the unit has not provided connectivity of flow meter to CPCB server; and

WHEREAS, the proper monitoring facility has not provided by the unit for incinerator & no designated storage for hazardous waste was provided by the unit: and

WHEREAS, the house keeping of the unit was not found satisfactory near sludge handling area & run off from stored sludge was found spread in the area; and

WHEREAS, on the basis of above stated observations directions under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act 1986, were issued by Central Pollution Control Board on August 16, 2017 to the unit to close down all operational activities with immediate effect; and

WHEREAS, it has been verified by the IT division of the CPCB on October 27, 2017 that the unit has provided the connectivity of the online monitoring system to the Central Pollution Control Board; and

WHEREAS, the Unit has submitted an undertaking of May 31, 2018 that it has complied with all directions issued by CPCB and if plant is found non-compliant during verification by CPCB officials, the Unit will accept to close down operations immediately and shall not operate till full compliance is achieved; and

WHEREAS, the unit vide self-certificate dated 30.05. 2018 stated that it has stopped production with effect from 30.05. 2018.

WHEREAS, the Unit has submitted the adequacy report of Effluent Treatment Plant from Faculty of Engineering Technology & Research, Surat, a GPCB recognised environmental auditor on 12.06.2018.

WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-member committee vide office order dated 03.10.2017 having representative(s) from CPCB and MoEF&CC for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and


WHEREAS, the Three-member committee in its meeting held on 26.06.2018 examined the compliance report submitted by the Unit and recommended that the closure directions issued to the Unit may be revoked only for three months and CPCB shall inspect the unit within this period and final revocation may be considered after examining the outcome of inspection report by the committee.


WHEREAS, since the unit has stopped production with effect from 30.05. 2018 which is non-compliance of the closure direction issued by Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 vide letter dated August 16, 2017 for which action as per law shall be initiated separately.

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to ~~issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority~~ for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in exercise of powers vested to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and in view of notarized undertaking submitted by the unit under reference, the directions issued under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 **M/s Micas Organics Pvt. Ltd. (Unit- II), Plot No. 3102/3101 & 3108, IV Phase, GIDC, Vapi, Gujarat** vide letter dated August 16, 2017 is hereby revoked only for three months.

The Unit will ensure compliance with the norms. In case of non-compliance by the Unit action as deemed fit under the provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 shall be taken.
